**Subject: Oral Hearing in Anti-Subsidy Investigation concerning imports of ‘Textured Tempered Glass Whether Coated or Uncoated’ from Malaysia.**

This is for your information that in the above mentioned investigation **Shri Bidyut Behari Swain, IAS**, Special Secretary & Designated Authority will hold an **Oral Hearing on 24<sup>th</sup> July, 2020 at 1500 Hrs (IST)** through Digital Video Conferencing.

2. This Oral Hearing has been necessitated due to the reason that Shri Bhupinder Singh Bhalla, IAS, the then Designated Authority at the time of First Oral Hearing held on 26<sup>th</sup> February, 2020, has been succeeded by Shri Bidyut Behari Swain, IAS. This development mandates that a new oral hearing be held by the new Designated Authority as per the judgment of the Hon’ble Supreme Court in the matter of Automotive Tyre Manufacturer’s Association (ATMA) vs. Designated Authority, in Civil Appeal No. 949 of 2006 on 07-01-2011.

3. As per Rule 6 (6) of the Custom Tariff (identification and Assessment of Safeguard) Rules, 1997, *“The Director General may allow an interested party or its representative to present the information relevant to the investigation orally but such oral information shall be taken into consideration by the Designated Authority only when it is subsequently reproduced in writing”*.

4. Kindly intimate the name (s) and email address of person (s) who are expected to attend the Hearing. The details of the Digital Video Conferencing will be shared shortly.

5. You will be required to submit two copies of the written submissions of the views expressed at the hearing within the date and time schedule to be indicated on the date of the hearing.

**Technical Details for participation in the DVC pertaining to CVD investigation of  
'Textured Tempered Glass Whether Coated or Uncoated' from Malaysia on 24/7/2020  
at 1500 Hrs. (IST)**

1. The Digital Video conference (DVC) has been organised keeping in view the Covid-19 situation as is also mentioned in the Trade Notice 01/2020 dated 10.04.2020 extended vide Trade Notice No. 03/2020 dated 09.07.2020, uploaded on DGTR's website <http://www.dgtr.gov.in/sites/default/files/Trade%20Notice%20Covid%2019.pdf>.
2. To keep the participation manageable through digital mode, the number of participants of any interested party is restricted to two including the legal representative/coordinator. However, in cases where an interested party may require their additional persons to participate, the Authority may permit one additional participant for which request should be sent at least 24 hours in advance.
3. An interested party should provide: Name of the organisation/company, Mobile No, and Landline No (with country/state code) and Email of their legal representative/coordinator who would participate in the hearing. 4. The Directorate would share the weblink with the coordinator/legal representative of the interested party prior to the oral hearing who may share it further with their other permitted participants.
5. Since oral submissions are to be subsequently reproduced in writing by each interested party after the oral hearing, the interested parties are requested to be brief and restrict their oral submissions to key aspects only, by one of their representatives.
6. In case any participant who joins the DVC, is unable to complete his/her submission for any technical reason, may file written submission which will be taken on record. Further, all written submissions will be shared amongst all participating interested parties as per the usual practice so as to enable all interested parties to file rejoinders. The time schedule for written submissions and rejoinders will be informed during the oral hearing.
7. The concerned Embassy/Country representative office in India are requested to encourage/facilitate participation of the interested parties from their country in the oral hearing through DVC.

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
