## ORDER ( Date of Hearing 06.08.2020 )

1. The Commission vide order dated 23.06.2020 had directed the Petitioner, UPPCL to serve a copy of the Petition to the Respondents. The Respondents were also allowed one month time to file reply to the Petition and UPPCL was to file its rejoinder with in two weeks thereafter. The Commission had fixed the date of hearing as 04.08.2020 which was rescheduled to 06.08.2020 upon request of the Petitioner.

The matter came up for hearing today.

- 2. The Respondent No. 1, NTPC has filed its reply dated 25.07.2020. UPPCL has filed amended memo of parties dated 23.07.2020, with Mytrah Energy (India) Pvt. Ltd, and Srijan Energy System Pvt. Ltd. as Respondent No. 2 and 3. However, no impleadment application has been filed in this regard. UPPCL also filed its submission dated 23.07.2020. Subsequently UPPCL has filed its rejoinder dated 05.08.2020.
- 3. During the hearing, Shri Venkatesh, legal Counsel of the Respondent No. 1, NTPC has argued that NTPC, being a Central Generating Company is within the jurisdiction of CERC. Shri Sitesh Mukherjee, legal Counsel of the Petitioner has argued that the power under the Project is not from Generating Station of NTPC and UPPCL had filed Petition No. 1483/2019 for PPA approval before this
