	(A) For MES enlisted contractors	(i)	All contractors enlisted with MES in <b>Class "S"</b> and above shall be considered eligible.
		(ii)	They should not have adverse remarks in Work Load Report of Competent Engineer Authority.
		(iii)	Firm should have MoU with MNRE approved channel partners of rating 1A / 1B / 1C / 2A / 2B / 2C having experience as given in 8 D(i) here-in-after.
		(iv)	Enlisted contractors who are either MNRE approved channel partners themselves fulfilling the criteria laid down here-in-after or meeting the criteria laid down for un-enlisted contractors shall also be considered eligible.
	(B) MNRE approved channel partners, MNRE approved government agencies.	(i)	MNRE approved channel partners of rating 1A / 1B / 2A / 2B. MNRE approved government agencies having experience as given at 8 D(i) here-in-after and meeting the annual turnover, financial criteria, solvency, working capital commensurate with enlistment criteria of <b>Class "S"</b> contractor in MES.
		(ii)	They should not have adverse remarks in Work Load Report return of competent Engineer authority.
		(iii)	No recovery outstanding in Government Department.
		(iv)	Meeting Engineering establishment criteria of <b>Class "S"</b> contractor of MES is not required.
		(v)	They shall submit a copy of Police Verification from the Police Authority of the area where the registered office of the firm is located / Notarized copy of the valid Passport of Proprietor/each Partner/each Director.
	(C) For Un-enlisted contractors other than MNRE approved Channel Partners	(i)	Contractors (other than approved channel partners) meeting the annual turnover, financial criteria, solvency, working capital commensurate with enlistment criteria of <b>Class "S"</b> contractor in MES.
		(ii)	Firms should have MoU with MNRE approved channel partners of rating 1A / 1B / 1C / 2A / 2B / 2C having experience as given in 8 D(i) here-in-after.
		(iii)	They should not have adverse remarks in Work Load Report of Competent Engineer Authority.
		(iv)	No recovery outstanding in Government Department.
		(v)	Meeting Engineering establishment criteria of <b>Class "S"</b> contractor of MES is not required.
		(vi)	They shall submit a copy of Police Verification from the Police Authority of the area where the registered office of the firm is located / Notarized copy of the valid Passport of Proprietor/each Partner/each Director.

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(D) For All Contractors	(i)	Experience of having successfully completed Solar Power Plants in Government Department / PSU <b>during last seven years</b> ending last day of the month previous to the one in which applications are invited should be any of the following :-
		(a) One work of capacity $\geq$ 80% of capacity of plant specified in NIT.
		<b>OR</b>
		(b) Two works of capacity $\geq$ 50% of capacity of plant specified in NIT.
		<b>OR</b>
		(c) Three works of capacity $\geq$ 40% of capacity of plant specified in NIT.
		<b>Note:-</b> The above experience applies to MNRE approved channel partners with whom MOU is made with.
	(ii)	Contractor will not be allowed to execute the work by subletting or through power of attorney holder on his behalf to a third party / another firm <b>except sons / daughters of proprietor / partner / Director, Project Manager as per contract conditions.</b>
(iii)	In a tender, the MNRE approved channel partner can either bid as direct participant / bidder or under MOU with MES enlisted / un-enlisted contractor, but cannot bid simultaneously for the same tender as direct participant / bidder as also under MOU with MES enlisted / un-enlisted contractor	
(iv)	In case any violation of condition at 8D(iii) above is noticed, bids submitted directly by MNRE approved channel will be treated as invalid.	
(v)	MOU will be permitted between only one MNRE approved channel partner and one MES enlisted / un-enlisted contractor, bidding for the same tender.

**NOTES:**

- (a) The contractor enlisted **upto two classes below the eligible class** may also apply / bid. Application from **two classes** below eligible class applicants may also be considered in the event of inadequate response from the applicants of eligible class and one class below eligible class.
- (b) (i) Applications / bids not accompanied by scanned copies of requisite DD / Bankers Cheque towards cost of tender and Earnest Money (as applicable) shall not be considered for validation of 'T' bid and their finance bids will not be opened.
- (ii) Tenderers / bidders to note that they should ensure that their original DDs and Earnest Money (as applicable) are received within **05 days** of bid submission end date.
- (iii) In case of applications / bids from enlisted contractors of MES, where scanned copies of requisite DD / Bankers Cheque towards cost of tender has been uploaded but physical copies are not received by the stipulated date, finance bids will be opened. However, non-submission of physical copies of cost of tender shall be considered as willful negligence of the bidder with ulterior motives and such bidder shall be banned from bidding for a period of six months commencing from the date of opening of finance bid.
- (iv) In case of applications / bids from unenlisted contractors, where scanned copies of requisite DD / Bankers Cheque towards cost of tender has been uploaded but physical copies are not received by the stipulated date, finance bids will not be opened. Name of such contractors alongwith complete address shall be circulated for not opening of their bids for a period of six months commencing from the date of opening of finance bid.
- (v) In case of applications / bids( enlisted contractor as well as unenlisted contractor) where scanned copies of requisite Earnest money (as applicable) were uploaded but the same are not received in physical form within stipulated time, such bids shall not qualify for opening of finance bid.

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- (c) Contractors enlisted with MES shall upload following documents for checking eligibility:-
- (i) Application for bid in Firm's letter head
  - (ii) Enlistment letter
  - (iii) Scanned copy of DD towards cost of tender
  - (iv) MOU with MNRE approved Channel Partners with MNRE approval letter.

MNRE approval letter in the name of firm.
  - (v) Details of **similar nature of works executed during last seven years as detailed in 8 D(i) here-in-before**
  - (vi) Keeping in view the applicability of Goods Service Tax (GST) on all contracts, it is mandatory for the contractors to upload their GST Registration No. alongwith the T-Bid. This will be one of the criteria for qualifying in T-Bid. A Contractor who does not upload GST Registration No. shall be disqualified in the T-Bid evaluation and his Finance Bid shall not be opened.
- (d) Contractors not enlisted with MES will be required to upload necessary documents to prove their eligibility for enlistment in eligible class & category of work, including Affidavit for no recovery outstanding. List of documents required for enlistment in MES has been given in para 1.5 of section 1 of Part I of MES Manual on Contracts 2007 (Reprint 2012). The following documents shall also be uploaded amongst others:-
- (i) Details of **similar nature of works executed during last seven years as detailed in 8 D(i) here-in-before**, financial year-wise in tabular form giving name of work, Accepting Officer's details, viz, Address, Telephone, Fax No, E-mail ID etc, date of acceptance of tender and actual date of completion. This shall be duly signed by proprietor / all partners / authorised Director of Pvt / Public Ltd, as applicable. It should indicate whether extension was granted or compensation was levied. Attested copy of acceptance letter and completion certificate shall be enclosed of each work. In case performance report has been given by the client, same shall also be submitted duly attested.
  - (ii) Solvency Certificate and Working Capital Certificate issued by Scheduled bank.
  - (iii) Annual turnover certificate for last 2 years issued by Chartered Accountant along with relevant pages of audited balance sheets in support thereof.
  - (iv) In addition, the un-enlisted contractors shall also furnish affidavit on non Judicial stamp paper in the form of hard copy declaring their turnover for last 2 (Two) years.
  - (v) Scanned copy of DD towards cost of tender and earnest money.
  - (vi) MOU with MNRE approved Channel Partners with MNRE approval letter  
or  
MNRE approval letter in the name of firm.
  - (viii) Keeping in view the applicability of Goods Service Tax (GST) on all contracts, it is mandatory for the contractors to upload their GST Registration No. alongwith the T-Bid. This will be one of the criteria for qualifying in T-Bid. A Contractor who does not upload GST Registration No. shall be disqualified in the T-Bid evaluation and his Finance Bid shall not be opened.

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- (e) Contractor shall ensure compliance of the EPF and MP Act 1952, in case the work is awarded to him.
- (f) In case of rejection of technical / prequalification bid, contractor may appeal to next higher Engineer Authority i.e CESC, Pune on email id [asstdircontceengrpl-mes@nic.in](mailto:asstdircontceengrpl-mes@nic.in) with copy to the Accepting Officer on email id: [cezafb2-mes@nic.in](mailto:cezafb2-mes@nic.in) before scheduled date of opening of Finance bid whose decision shall be final and binding. However contractor / bidder shall not be entitled to any compensation whatsoever for rejection of technical / prequalification bid.

**Note:-**

1. Court of the place from where tender has been issued shall alone have jurisdiction to decide any dispute out of or in respect of this tender. After acceptance of tender Condition-72 of Jurisdiction of Courts of IAFW-2249 shall be applicable.
