1. The instant Petition has been filed by the Petitioner namely Uttar Pradesh Sugar Mills Cogen Association, which is a representative body of sugar mills in the State of U.P., having 15 members. The Association is registered under the Uttar Pradesh Societies Registration Act in the year 2005.
