Executive Officer, North 24 Parganas Zilla Parishad, invites **percentage rate e-tender** for the following work mentioned as above, from resourceful contractors either enlisted of this Zilla Parishad or bonafied outsiders, Govt. contractors registered with P.W.D./ Irrigation and Water Ways Department / Housing Deptt./ C.P.W.D. & enlisted contractors of other Engineering Deptt. of the Govt. having experience in same type of works.

Basic Qualification Criteria:

(A) Credential: The applicant, in the same name and style, as prime contractor should have successfully completed at least one contract of same type of work at least one-third value of the proposed contract within the last 5 years. Only one credential certificate need to be uploaded which satisfies the work criteria. In case of multiple credential only the 1st credential uploaded will be considered for evaluation.

(B) Turnover: The bidder should have achieved in any one year during last five financial years in the same name and style (excluding current year) a minimum financial turnover as certified by chartered accountant and at least 50% of which is from civil engineering construction works) equivalent to amount given below. Payment certificate must be uploaded to corroborate the figure of Audit Report. In case the payment certificate uploaded is found to be less than value mentioned in Audit Report, the tenderer is treated as cancel. the less value will be considered as turn over for Bid Capacity calculation after indexing @ 8%. In that case turnover will be taken as double the indexed value based on uploaded payment certificates.

- i) 100% of amount put to bid in case of the amount put to bid is up to Rs. 25 lakh and
- ii) 75% of Amount put to bid in case of the amount put to bid above Rs. 25 lakhs for which bid has been invited.
- (C) Documents & Certificates: Self Attested copies of IT Return (for the last 5 years), P.Tax, GST, Registration Certificate must be produced by all bidders and for registered Engineers Co-Operative Society & Registered labour Co-Operative Society including submission of Bye-Laws, valid audit report for the last three (3) years, valid ARCS certificates and other papers & submit the same with full address of their and authorized person to sign on tender documents along with Technical Bid papers.

<u>Additional Qualification Criteria:</u> Bidders who meet the minimum qualification criteria will be qualified only if their available bid capacity for construction work is equal to or more than the total bid value. The available bid capacity will be calculated as under:

Assessed Available Bid capacity = (A*N*M - B) Where

A = Maximum value of civil engineering works executed in any one year during the last five years (updated to the price level to the last year at the rate of 8 percent a year) taking into account the completed as well as works in progress, N = Number of year prescribed for completion of the work for which bids are invited (period upto 6 months to be taken as $\frac{1}{2}$ and more than 6 months as 1 in a year, M = 3, B = Value, at the current indexed @ 8% per Annual price level, of existing commitments and ongoing works to be completed during the period of completion of the works for which bids are invited.

N.B. The statements showing the value of existing commitments and on-going works as well as the stipulated period of completion remaining for each of the works listed should be countersigned by the Engineer in charge, not below the rank of an Executive Engineer or equivalent. Otherwise those Certificates will not be considered in the Evaluation process.

<u>Disqualification Criteria:</u> Even though the bidders meet the above qualifying criteria, they are subject to be disqualified if they have:

- (i) Made misleading or false representations in the forms, statements, affidavits and attachments submitted in proof of the qualification requirements; and / or record of submission of any false / fake document(s).
- (ii) Record of poor performance such as abandoning the works, not properly completing the contract, inordinate delays in completion, litigation history, or financial failures etc.
- (iii) Participated in the previous bidding for the same work and had quoted unreasonably high or low bid prices and could not furnish rational justification for it to the Employer.
- (iv) All the supporting documents i.e. list of completed works etc. should preferably be typed not hand written to avoid disqualification due to illegibility.

Bids from joint ventures - Not allowed

Sub-contract for works not allowed.

Rejection Criteria: During scrutiny of Technical Bid / Tender documents, or any time prior to opening of financial bid, if it is found that any information in any supportive document is false or incorrect/misleading to that extent, that it frustrates the very basis of submission of that document, then the tender of the concerned bidder will be rejected, without assigning any reason whatsoever. If it is found that there is continuous poor performance and inordinate delay in execution of the works already awarded to them. The Executive Officer / Addl. Executive Officer, North 24 Parganas Zilla Parishad will have sole discretion to decide the eligibility of the Contractors on the basis of his submitted documents and evaluation thereof and reserve the right to refuse any explanation to Contractor or to refuse issuance of tender to any applicant without assigning any reason thereof and the decision of the Zilla Parishad in this respect will be final.

Special Terms & Condition:

- 1. The work in which Design Mix concrete like M20, M25, M30 are to be used the agency must have Weigh Batching instruments to execute the work.
- 2. The agency executing Design Mix Concrete should note that Mix Design Report is to be submitted by the agency prior to execution of the work. The cost if any to this effect will be

borne by the agency. Design Mix Concrete Report must be submitted from recognized Govt. institute and expenditure will be borne by agency.

- 3. If any admixture is likely to be used as per advice of Mix Design Report the cost to this effect will be borne by the agency.
- 4. Payment will be made on measured quantity & test reports conducted.
- 5. Certificate of Safety Equipments should be available with the intending bidders.
- 6. Bank solvency certificate should be submitted in the given format otherwise bid of the tenderer will be treated as canceled.
- 7. Message regarding "Technically Qualified/Disqualified" will be communicated to the Bidders. Financial Bid will be opened within a short period after such communication. In case of there be any objection regarding Technical Scrutiny, objection should be lodged to the under signed and submitted to CA section of AEO, ZP within 48 hours from time of uploading of the Technical Bid and subsequently communication to Bidder. Beyond that time schedule no objection will be entertained.
- 8. Issue of Work Order will be subject to verification of original documents of the lowest bidder.
- 9. For new construction & or maintenance of building works agency should maintain proper safety measures at worksite which should be supported by proper documentation of safety equipments & skilled manpower during submission of bid.
- 10. The bidders may be asked to be present during the time of technical evaluation alongwith their relevant original documents, if required.

11. (i) For Works Serial No.-1 (Civil Works):-

The Bidder must have similar credential. The credential certificate should be issued by the rank of Executive Engineer or rank of D.D.O. from any Government Organisation.

(ii) For Work Serial No.-2 (Solar System Works):-

The Bidder must have the similar credential. The credential certificate should be issued by the rank of Executive Engineer or rank of D.D.O. from any Government Organisation.

14. SPECIAL CONDITIONS FOR ELECTRICAL INSTALLATIONS:-

General

1. These special conditions are part of the Contractor and the contractor shall go through it as he shall not have any right to claim at any time for delays or for expenditure incurred by him in fulfilling the following special conditions.

Special conditions of contractor (SCC) shall be read in conjunction with Technical Specifications, schedule of Quantities, Tender drawings and any other document forming part of this contract Agreement.

1.1 Electrical License:-

The agency shall employee licensed supervisors and skilled workers having valid permits as per the regulations of Indian Electricity Rules and local Electrical Inspectors requirements.

1.2 Conformity to IE Act, IE Rules, and BIS standards:-

- a) All Electrical works shall be carried out in accordance with provisions of Indian electricity Act, 1910 and Indian Electricity Rules, 1956 amended up to date (Date of call of tender unless specified otherwise).
- b) The definition of terms shall be in accordance with IS: 732-1989 (Indian standard Code of Practice for Electrical wiring), except for the definitions of point, circuit and

sub main wiring which are defined in the General specifications for Electrical works Part-1 internal 2013.

c) All components shall conform to relevant Indian Standard (BIS) specifications, wherever existing. Materials with ISI certification mark shall be preferred.

1.3 Storage of Solar Installation:

The solar panels along with allied materials should be opened and kept in the suitable place as provided by the authority of North 24 Parganas Zilla Parishad.

a. Statutory Clearance (s):-

Approval /Clearance of the work shall be obtained by the contractor from local bodies and other licensing authorities, wherever required. However application shall be made available by the BMTPC to the contractor and any statutory fee, as applicable, shall be paid by the Contractor directly to the Govt. authorities concerned & the same would be reimbursed by BMTPC on production of proof of payment.

Pay any licensing fee/submission fee/ inspection fee payable to statutory authorities for obtaining above approvals.

Complying with observations, if any, of Electrical inspector / or any other Statutory Authority after completion of work in order to obtain a categorical clearance to start beneficial use.

- b. A declaration of warranty of LED light including electrical fittings for 5 years or as per manufacturer guide lines shall have to submitted by the bidder through an affidavits.
- c. OEM authorization / warranty to be signed either by at least area manager or equivalent category executive.
- d. The OEM authorization letter should be included within technical bid.

<u>Additional Performance Security</u>:- Additional Performance Security when the bid rate is 80% or less of the Estimate put to tender and no increase in scope of work of projects during execution phase.

1.In tenders for Government works, bids are sometimes received at a much lower rate than the Estimated Amount put to tender. In such cases, to ensure the quality and proper execution of the work in public interest, the Governor is pleased to decide that Additional Performance Security @ 10% of the tendered amount shall be obtained from the successful bidder if the accepted bid value is 80% or less of the Estimate put to tender.

- 2. The Additional Performance Security shall be submitted in the form of Bank Guarantee from any Scheduled Bank before issuance of the Work Order. If the bidder fails to submit the Additional Performance Security within seven working days from the date of issuance of Letter of Acceptance, his Earnest Money will be forfeited and other necessary actions as per NIT like blacklisting of the contractor, etc, may be taken. The Bank Guarantee shall have to be valid up to end of the Contract Period and shall be renewed accordingly, if required.
- 3. The Bank Guarantee shall be returned immediately on successful completion of the Contract. If the bidder fails to complete the work successfully, the Additional Performance Security shall be forfeited at any time during the pendency of the contract period after serving proper notice to the contractor. Necessary provisions regarding deduction of security deposit from the progressive bills of the contractor as per relevant clauses of the contract shall in no way be altered/affected by provision of this Additional Performance Security.
- 4. Henceforth, necessary provision shall be incorporated in all Notice Inviting Tenders and shall be part of the Contract Agreement.
- 5. This order will take immediate effect and necessary amendment in the West Bengal Financial Rules shall be made in due course.

<u>Unbalanced Bid:</u> The bid in which the offered rate is 10% below SOR extra 5% security deposit above normal 10% Security Deposit will be deducted from bill of contractor i.e. to say that 15% Security Deposit will be retained in case of unbalance bid (Ref: As per decision of Atrha Sthayee Samity on 19/02/15), proper Financial Analysis of Rate must be justified by the bidder in case of Unbalanced bid.

Forfeiture of Earnest Money: Apart from Disqualification and Rejection of tender the Earnest Money deposited by the bidder will be <u>forfeited</u> if they submit <u>false/fake/forged</u> documents in respect of Credential and Turnover.
