- h) After approval of the case by the Competent Authority, the consumer shall be intimated through registered post/by hand for depositing the requisite charges under One Time Settlement.
- Once a relief under this scheme is availed, no further review/relief shall be admissible and the case finalized under this scheme shall not be referable to any DSC/Forum for Redressal of Grievances of consumer/ Ombudsman/ Judicial Courts etc.
- j) The cases of Theft and Unauthorized use of Electricity as per Reg-36 & 37 of Supply Code shall not be covered in this scheme.
- k) Dy.CE/SE Operation and Addl.SE/Sr.Xen Operation shall give wide publicity of the scheme to apprise the Consumers about the consumer friendly One Time Settlement Scheme introduced by PSPCL.

NOTES

THE FOLLOWING GUIDELINES SHALL BE FOLLOWED FOR ALLOWING RECONNECTION:-

i) All categories of consumers including general category of Industrial consumers shall be required to deposit Rs.2,000/- as processing fee along-with their option/undertaking whereas in case of Power Intensive Units, the processing fee shall be Rs.5,000/-. However, this fee shall be adjusted towards their final settlement bill. In case consumer fails to deposit the requisite charges for reconnection intimated through the subsequent notice then the processing fee deposited with the PSPCL shall be forfeited and the consumer's request for allowing reconnection shall be deemed to be cancelled.

In reference to the subject cited above, it is requested that One Time Settlement Scheme was introduced by PSPCL vide above referred circular for all category of consumers (except Δz who's connections were lying disconnected or who were in some kind of dispute in respect of their bills and want out of court settlement. The validity of this scheme was for six months from the date of issue of circular i.e. upto 12.12.2019."

In this regards we want to submit that, you are well aware about the sick position of Industrial Units in the state of Punjab and unemployment of youth. Further, there is a surplus power in the State of Punjab. Sick Industrial units, which are shut down due to their finance constraints, are always willing to revive their units. Electricity is a major need for any Industria Unit for its continuity. Revival of these units may boost up the employment in the State. It may also benefits the State by generating Revenue and can generate additional revenue for PSPCL a. consuming its surplus power.

Keeping in view the financial position of Industrial Units and surplus power position of the State, this Association request your goodself to extend the One Time Settlement Scheme, as issued vide above referred circular, for another one year.

We further request you to relax the condition of charging interest on the defaulting amount outstanding against the disconnected consumer and also to waive off the condition of deposit of Fixed Charges/MMC of one year.
