### ORDER

(Date of Hearing: 08th July, 2021)

- M/s Shree Cement Limited (hereinafter referred as Petitioner) is a company engaged in the business of cement manufacturing and generation of power. The Petitioner submitted that it is a cement grinding unit in the state of Uttar Pradesh. The Petitioner submitted that it is a consumer of M/s Paschimanchal Vidyut Vitran Nigam Limited (PVVNL) with a contract demand of 14.4 MVA and is availing power under Open Access facility of upto 12.24 MW through Power Exchange or from other Open Access Sources. Further, it is the contention of the Petitioner that the Respondent, PVVNL has levied the average distribution loses retrospectively in his Open Access related bills. The counter-affidavit in the matter has been filed by the Respondent, PVVNL. Subsequently, the Petitioner has also filed a rejoinder.
- 2 The matter was listed for hearing today on 8<sup>th</sup> July, 2021. However, Member (Law) is on leave today. As per the directions of Hon'ble Supreme Court in its Order dated. 12<sup>th</sup> April, 2018 in Civil Appel No. 14697 of 2015 (State of Gujrat & Ors. Vs.
