- 12. From the above table, it is observed that the RPO quantum is quite low and no generator has agreed for supply of such quantum at competitive rate. After exercising commercial prudence, it was decided to purchase RECs from Power Exchange but due to less inventory and vivid demand in market, the RECs were cleared at Forbearance Price.
- 13. The Petitioner submits that it had made sincere efforts to source RE power and purchase RECs from Power Exchange but was unsuccessful during FY 2019-20 due to supply constraints of both RE power and RECs. Purchase of RECs at Forbearance Price would increase the financial burden of the petitioner and consequently would result in increase of cost of supply which will indeed incur burden to Consumers.
- 14. As per the GERC Principal Regulations on Procurement of Energy from Renewable Sources-2010, the petitioner requests Hon'ble Commission to kindly revise the RPO target for compliance in FY 2019-20 due to difficulty in transition from a UGVCL Consumer to power procurement as a distribution licensee. The request is being prayed in accordance with the clause 4.2 of the principal RPO regulations. The excerpt from the clauses reads as follows:
  - "4.2 The Commission may, suo-motu or at the request of a licensee, revise the percentage targets for a year as per clause 4.1 of these Regulations keeping in view supply constraints or other factors beyond the control of the licensee."
- 15. The RPO regulations confers the power to Hon'ble Commission for revising the RPO target based on the request of the licensee on account of supply constraints or due to other factors beyond the control of the licensee.



16. Subsequently, keeping in view of the above mentioned points the petitioner humbly requests the Hon'ble Commission to kindly revise the RPO targets and exempt us from RPO Compliance of FY 2019-20 due to difficulty in transition from a consumer to distribution licensee and considering the factors of supply constraint for compact load.

- g. To grant any relief/s as it deems fit and appropriate under the circumstances of the case and in the interest of justice.
