One order executed for "similar item" Design, SITC of Off Grid Solar PV Plant of capacity not less than 4 kWP where executed value is not less than the amount equal to Rs. 2089452.

FOB/FCA/FOR Dispatch point price (inclusive of P&F, if any) shall be considered for arriving at the executed order value. Disclaimer
