DAILY ORDER

1. The matter was kept for hearing on 03.09.2021.
2. When the matter was called out, nobody was present on behalf of the Petitioner and Respondents No. 3, 5 and 6.
3. In response to query of the Commission regarding amendment of Petition and inclusion of additional prayers sought by the Petitioner vide affidavit dated 25.02.2020, Shri Jignesh Langalia on behalf of the Respondent No. 2 TPL, submitted that the same is not received by TPL and argued that it is necessary verify the contents of amendments sought for which the Commission may direct the Petitioner to make available aforesaid amendment affidavit to the Respondent TPL and requested the Commission to grant one week time to file reply/objection to the amendments sought by the Petitioner.
4. Shri Hetal Patel on behalf of the Respondent GUVNL submitted that one week time to file reply/objection to the amendments sought by the Petitioner be also granted to GUVNL.
5. We note that the Petitioner neither remained present during today's proceedings nor made any written communication about their inability to remain present, despite being served the hearing notice to them in advance. As the Petitioner has not remained present today, the matter stands adjourned due to non-appearance of the Petitioner.
- 5.1. We also note the submissions of the Respondent TPL regarding non-receipt of Petitioner's letter dated 25.02.2020 forwarding affidavit dated 25.02.2020 seeking

amendment in the Petition and prayer clauses and requesting the Commission to direct the Petitioner to make available the aforesaid amendment affidavit to enable filing their reply on amendment within a week time after receipt. Also, GUVNL sought time to file its reply to amendment sought by the Petitioner. Accordingly, the Petitioner is directed to serve aforesaid affidavit dated 25.02.2020 seeking amendment in the Petition and prayer clauses to the Respondents including TPL.

5.2. The Respondents are also directed to file their reply, if any, to amendment in the Petition and prayer clauses as sought by the Petitioner vide affidavit dated 25.02.2020 within a weeks' time from receipt of same, with copy to the Petitioner.

5.3. Since, the present matter is now taken up for hearing by the Commission, the prayer in I.A. No. 11 of 2021 for urgent listing of the Petition is satisfied. Accordingly, I.A. No. 11 of 2021 is disposed.

6. The next date of hearing is on 16.09.2021 at 11:30 A.M.
