1. Heard Mr. Buddy A Ranganadhan, Counsel for the Petitioner and Ms. Tanya Sareen, Counsel for the Respondent, SECI. Sh. Buddy A Ranganadhan has fairly informed the Commission that the CERC while granting the approval has adopted the tariff of the individual power stations. The PSA already agreed between the Petitioner and the SECI will be required to be amended only to this limited extent. He submitted that for this legal requirement he will require a very short time, say, 10 days' time to put the records straight and make the necessary amendment. The prayer is legal and genuine. Ten days' time as prayed is granted to Mr. Ranganadhan to incorporate the amendment. Meanwhile Ms. Tanya Sareen may file any reply, if she so chooses.
