Order (Date of Hearing: 28.09.2021)

1. The last hearing in the matter was held on 09.03.2021 and the Commission vide Order dated 12.03.2021 directed UPPCL to submit revised computation mentioning data points/sources and rationale for arriving at APPC within a weeks' time with a copy to DCM Shriram Limited and the Petitioner was directed to file rejoinder within a week. UPPCL filed its reply on 19.03.2021 and 31.03.2021. The Petitioner has not filed any rejoinder. The matter was scheduled for hearing on 06.04.2021 but could not be held due to pandemic situation.

The matter came up for the hearing today.

2. On a specific query of the Commission, regarding the APPC rate, Shri. Suhail Buttan, Counsel, DCM Shriram Ltd. submitted that UPPCL while computing APPC rate have taken all sources of power actually incurred in FY 2017-18 itself, whereas

the Regulation prescribes that APPC rate for any particular financial year is computed taking data of previous financial year. Shri. Suhail Buttan, sought further time to file a rejoinder on the submissions of the UPPCL and fix date of next hearing.

- 3. Shri. Mohit Goyal, Consultant, UPPCL submitted that they have filed their reply in compliance to the Commission's Order dated 30.11.2017. He further submitted that as per PPA clause 2.1, the tariff for payment is to be the APPC for FY 2017-18, which works out to be Rs. 3.48/kWh.
- 4. The Commission was inclined to conclude the hearing and pass appropriate orders, however, on the request of Shri. Suhail Buttan, Counsel, DCM Shriram Ltd., the Commission granted two weeks' time to file their written submissions.
