On behalf of Bihar State Power Holding Company Ltd. (BSPHCL), Mr. Abhijeet Kumar, Chief Engineer alongwith Mr. Rajeev Kr. Singh, ESE and Mr. Amit Kumar, AEE were also present during the course of hearing.</p> <p>This instant petition has been filed by the petitioner-BSPHCL seeking approval to waive off solar RPO shortfall for FY 2020-21 after adjusting carry forward of FY 2019-20 in accordance with the provisions of BERC's Renewable Purchase Obligation compliance, REC framework implementation regulations and Conduct of Business Regulations along with amendments therein. After careful examination, the petition stands admitted by the Commission.</p> <p>The petitioner advanced their submissions in favour of their petition. The Commission has directed the petitioner to submit their response on following queries:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Petitioner shall submit consolidated data regarding tie ups of RE power for which approval from BERC shall be required in near future, apart from the instant petition, for the achievement of RPO. - Petitioner has filed this petition for waiving off the solar RPO short fall for FY 2020-21 after adjusting carry forward of FY 2019-20. However, there is no such provision of exemption of RPO shortfall whereas there is only provision of carry forward of purchase of REC. - Petitioner has submitted detailed calculation of Renewable Purchase Obligation for FY 2019-20 and FY 2020-21 but it is not in line with Tariff Order dated 26.03.2021. - Petitioner has submitted the net shortfall for NBPDC is 458.42 MUs and for SBPDCL is 662.51 MUs respectively but it is not in line with BERC(Renewable Purchase Obligation, its compliance and Implementation of REC
