9. Performance Security:

10. Security Deposit:

The security deposit (Retention Money) @ 5% shall be deducted from each running bill of the contractor which shall be released after successful completion of the work.

11. No price escalation:

The rates and price quoted by the bidder shall be deemed to include any price escalation upto completion of the work unless otherwise specified separately.

12. Taxes:

The rates and price quoted by the bidder should be in Indian rupees only and the quoted rates shall be deemed to include all taxes, royalties, levies, surcharge etc. Upto completion of the work unless otherwise separately and exclusively specified. The deduction of amount of applicable taxes from the bills of the Contractor shall be same as per prevailing rates at the time of effecting recovery.

13. Visit to Site:

14. Force Majure:

In circumstances beyond the control of the Contractor, time extension for completion of the contracted work may be given by the Corporation at the request of the contractor keeping in view the time elapsed due to circumstances beyond the control of the contractor.

15. Employer's and Contractor's Risk:

The Employer carries the risks which this Contract states are Employer's risks, and the Contractor carries the risks which this contract states are Contractor's risks.

(a). Employer's Risks:

The Employer is responsible for the excepted risks which are (a) in so far as they directly affect the execution of the works in the Employer's country, the risks of war, hostilities, invasion, act of foreign enemies, rebellion, revolution, insurrection or military or usurped power, civil war, riot commotion or disorder (unless restricted to the Contractor's employee's), and contamination from any nuclear fuel or nuclear waste or radioactive toxic explosive, or(b) a cause solely due to the design of the works, other than the Contractor's design.

(b). Contractor's Risks:

All risks of loss of or damage to physical property and of personal injury and death which arise during and in consequence of the performance of the contract other than the excepted risks are the responsibility of the Contract.

16. Advance payment/Mobilization advance

No mobilization advance or advance payment in any manner shall be made to the Contractor unless otherwise specifically provided in the bid document or the work contract.

17. Penalty for delay in completion of work:

- a. In case of delay in completion of the work beyond scheduled period of completion (as per allotment), a penalty at the rate of 1% per month (on pro-rata basis) on the amount of allotted work shall be imposed on the Contractor subject to a maximum of 10% of the contract value.
- b. Non-cooperation of the Contractor or his representative with PHC officers and any act of misbehaviour or disrespectful conduct by the Contractors or his representative with PHC Staff shall invite penalty as decided by the Managing Director, J&K PHC which shall be binding on the Contractor.

18. Arbitration:

No arbitration is allowed.

19. Dispute Resolution Mechanism:

If any dispute or difference of any kind what-so-ever arise between the PHC, its authorized representatives and the Contractor in connection with or arising out of the contract or the execution of work, it will be first attempted to be resolved amicably at the Division Level.

However, if the dispute still remains unresolved, then the parties shall proceed in accordance with the conciliation procedure set forth below: -

- a) Whether before its commencement or during the progress of Project/ works or after the termination, abandonment or breach of the Contract, the dispute shall in the first instance supported with complete documents and further documents, if any required by the other party, be referred for settlement to the Superintending Engineer, J&K Police Housing Corporation (SE, PHC) who shall, within a period of thirty (30) days after being requested in writing by either party, mediate and convey his decision.
- b) If the SE, PHC has conveyed his decision and no party has contested within a period of thirty (30) days from the receipt of the letter of communication of the decision, the said decision shall be final and binding upon both the parties and will not be a subject matter of arbitration at all.
- c) In case of disagreement with the decision of SE, PHC either party may refer such Dispute to the Managing Director, J&K Police Housing Corporation for amicable settlement whose decision shall be final and binding to both the parties.

The Jurisdiction of the court in any case shall be within Union Territory of J&K.

20. Documents comprising the bid:

Following documents which are not submitted with the bid shall be deemed to be part of the bid :

- a) Notice Inviting Tender
- b) Tender Document.
- c) Drawings

21. Integrity of the bid process:

Information relating to clarification, examination, evaluation, comparison of bids, recommendations for award of contract, approval thereof etc. during the bid process are confidential. All bidders are advised not to make any attempt to influence any officer/official of the department or any person related to them. Any such attempt may result in disqualification of the bidder at any stage of the bid process including appropriate action under existing provisions of law.

22. Production of original documents on demand:

All bidders including the successful bidder will have to produce original documents before the Corporation at any stage of the bid process or even during execution of the work contract, on demand, for verification or for any other purpose.

23. Termination of Contract by Engineer-in-charge:-

- (i) If the Contractor fails to carry out any obligation under the Contract, the Engineer in charge may, by notice, require the Contractor to make good the failure and to correct it within a specified reasonable time.
- (ii) The engineer in charge shall be entitled to terminate the contract if:
 - a. The Contractor abandons the works or otherwise plainly demonstrates the intention not to continue with performance of his obligations under the contract;
 - b. The Contractor is declared as bankrupt or goes into liquidation other than for approved reconstruction or amalgamation;
 - c. The Contractor without reasonable excuse fails to comply with the notice or fails to comply to the instructions of PHC officers within a reasonable period of time even after 03 notices.
 - d. The Contractor does not maintain a valid instrument of financial Security, as prescribed;
 - e. The Contractor has delayed the completion of the Works by such duration beyond the maximum amount recoverable through Penalty.
 - f. The Contractor , in the judgment of the engineer in charge has engaged in corrupt or fraudulent practices in competing for or in executing the contract;

Corrupt practice means: offering, giving, receiving or soliciting of anything of value to influence the action of a public official in the procurement process or in contract execution.

"Fraudulent practice" means a misrepresentation of facts in order to influence a procurement process or the execution of a contract to the detriment of the Borrower, and includes collusive practice amongst Bidders (prior to or after bid submission) designed to establish bid prices at artificial non-competitive levels and to deprive the Borrower of the benefits of free and open competition.

g. Any other fundamental breach of the contract condition. The fundamental breach of contract includes but shall not be limited to the following: -

(i) The Contractor stops work for 28 days when no stoppage of work has been shown on the current programme and the stoppage has not been authorized by the Engineer-in-charge.

(ii) If the Contractor fails to deploy machinery/ equipment or personnel as required to maintain the progress of work to complete within the stipulated date of completion.

(iii) The Engineer gives Notice for failure to correct a particular defect and the Contractor fails to correct it within a reasonable period of time determined by the engineer-in-charge.

(iv) If the Contractor does not comply to the terms and conditions of the contract.

In any of the above events or circumstances, the Engineer in Charge may, upon giving 14days notice to the Contractor, terminate the contract.

Notwithstanding the above, the Corporation may terminate the Contract for convenience.

If the contract is terminated, the Contractor shall stop work immediately, make the Site safe and secure and level the site without shifting any equipment as soon as possible.

24. Payment upon Termination:

If the Contract is terminated because of a fundamental breach of Contract by the Contractor, the Engineer shall issue a certificate for the value of the work done less penalty, advance payments received up to the date of the issue of the certificate, less other recoveries due in terms of the contract, less taxes due to be deducted at source as per applicable law and less the percentage to apply to the value of work not completed representing the Employers additional cost for completing the Works which shall be 20 percent. If the amount due to the Employer exceeded any payment due to the Contractor, the difference shall be recovered from any other security of the Contractor available with PHC either of the contract in question or of any other contract.

If the Contract is terminated at the Employer's convenience or because of a fundamental breach of Contract by the Employer, the Engineer shall issue a certificate for the value work done, the reasonable cost of removal of Equipment, repatriation of the Contractor's personnel employed solely on the Works, and the Contractor's cost of protecting and securing the work less other recoveries due in terms of the contract and less taxes due to be deducted at sources as per applicable law

25. Property :

All materials at the Site, Plants, Equipment set care deemed to be the property of the Corporation, if the Contract is terminated because of default of the Contractor.

26. Release from Performance:

If the Contract is frustrated by outbreak of a war or by any other event entirely beyond the control of either the Corporation or the Contractor, the concerned Executive Engineer shall certify that the Contract has been frustrated. The Contractor shall make the Site safe and stop work as quickly as possible after receiving this certificate and shall be paid for executed items of work.

27. Extension of time for Completion of Work:

The Corporation may extend the Intended Completion Date if delay is on part of Corporation or Employer's Risk or due to Force Majure or a variation is issued or due to any other reason not attributable to the contractor.

The Corporation shall decide whether and by how much to extend the intended Completion Date. If the Contractor fails to give early warning of a delay or has failed to cooperate in dealing with a delay, the delay by this failure shall not be considered in assessing the new Intended Completion Date.

28. Discoveries:

Anything of historical or other interest or of significant value discovered at the site is the property of the Corporation. The contractor has to notify the Executive Engineer of such discoveries and carry out the Engineer's instructions for dealing with them.

29. Insurance:

The Contractor shall provide, in the joint names of the Corporation and the Contractor insurance cover from the start date to the end of the Defect Liability Period to cover the following risks:

a) loss of or damage to the Works, Plant and Materials;

b) loss of or damage to Equipment; loss of or damage of property (except the works, Plant, Materials and Equipment) in connection with the Contract; and personal injury of death to work force.

30. General and Special conditions:

- (i) TIME IS THE ESSENCE OF THE CONTRACT. Contractor should complete the work within the scheduled date of completion failing which the Penalty shall be imposed upon the contractor as provided in the relevant clause.
- (ii) The J&K Police Housing Corporation shall be referred herein, in the tender document as Corporation or J&K, PHC or PHC or Employer or department.
- (iii) Date of start of work shall be reckoned after 7 days from the date of issuance of letter of Intent/allotment of work as the case may be. The agreement shall have to be signed within 28 days of issuance of Letter of allotment /Letter of intent.
- (iv) All Documents related to the bid shall be in English language only. Any document in other than English language should be translated in English language by the bidder.
- (v) Sub-letting of the contract or any part thereof is not allowed.
- (vi) The Corporation reserves the right to accept or reject any or all the bids before or after opening of bids or at any stage of the bid process without assigning any reason thereof.
- (vii) The Corporation reserves the right to award the contract to any of the bidder in the interest of the work without assigning any reason thereof.
