#### ORDER

# (Date of Public hearing 17.01.2022)

- 1. LPGCL has filed Petition for approval of Capital cost and tariff determination of its 2x660 MW Project, the last unit having been declared under commercial operation on 23.12.2016. The Commission vide order dated 05.07.2019 has decided to appoint Designated Independent Agency (DIA) for conducting prudence check of capital cost of the Project. M/s Aquagreen Pvt. Ltd, was appointed DIA in July 20 and submitted its final report on 29.10.2021.
- The final report along with its annexures, queries of the Commission, DIA reply were uploaded on the Commission's website and Public Notice dated 23.11.2021 was published in Newspaper for inviting



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comments of the stakeholders and holding Public hearing on 17.01.2022.

- 3. The Public hearing was held today, wherein UPPCL, the Respondent, Sh. Avdhesh, Verma, Adhyaksh U.P. Rajay Vidyut Upbhokta Parishad and Sh. Rama Shankar Awasthi, Consumer representative have deliberated their comments. UPPCL has submitted disallowances to the tune of Rs. 4,643 Crs in the project cost.
- 4. The issues highlighted by various stakeholders cover various disallowances in LPGCL capital cost including those of:
  - (a) disallowance of profit margins out of related parties' transactions & not following competitive bidding process for contract award
  - (b) disallowing abnormal cost increase against various packages
  - (c) reduction in surplus land expenditure incurred for Green belt & LPGCL Phase-II project
  - (d) disallowing exchange rate variation due to unhedged position, disallowing increase in expenses related to canal lining & railway siding
  - (e) disallowing exorbitant design engineering and project expenses
  - (f) disallowing cost increase due to imported coal use etc.
  - (g) disallowing expenses on pipeline related to water reservoir
  - (h) accounting for Mega Power benefit in LPGCL project cost
  - (i) disallowing IDC before Financial closure of the Project
  - (j) disallowing free issue material cost provided by LPGCL
  - (k) disallowing CSR expenses in the capital cost of the Project
  - (I) Capital cost benchmarking of LPGCL project with similarly placed projects
  - (m) Checking for pari-passu debt equity ratio
  - (n) Proportionate reduction in IDC for disallowances in Project cost



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- 5. The stakeholders sought a week's time further to submit additional comments. Sh. Amit Kapur, Counsel, LPGCL has also requested two weeks to file their replies to the comments.
- 6. The Commission, therefore, allowing request of stakeholders, directs UPPCL, Sh. Avdhesh, Verma and Sh. Rama Shankar Awasthi to submit all their comments by 27th January 2022 with a copy to the Petitioner. LPGCL is also directed to file their replies within two weeks i.e., by  $11^{\rm th}$ February 2022.
