ORDER

1. The present petition has been filed by M/s. HPGCL seeking to remove the difficulty arising out of Regulation 34 (3) (iii) of HERC MYT Regulations, 2019 to the extent that norms for the compensation for secondary fuel oil consumption due to Multiple Start/Stop of Units under Reserve Shutdown (RSD), may be specified particularly for 300 MW DCRTTP and 600 MW RGTPP units of HPGCL. The specific relief sought by the petitioner is as under: -
 - a) The oil consumption per start up norms for 300 MW DCRTTP and 600 MW RGTPP Units of HPGCL as proposed earlier by HPGCL, may please be approved as under:-

Unit Size (MW)	Oil Consumption per start up (KI)		
	Hot	Warm	Cold
300 MW	30	50	80
600 MW	40	60	110

- b) Pass such further order or order(s) as the Commission may deem fit.

2. The case was heard through video conferencing, in view of COVID-19 pandemic, on 02.03.2022, as scheduled. The Commission observes that the prayer of the petitioner has already been addressed by the Commission in the Haryana Electricity Regulatory Commission (Terms and Conditions for Determination of Tariff for Generation, Transmission, Wheeling and Distribution & Retail Supply under Multi Year Tariff Framework) Regulations, 2019, 2nd Amendment Regulations, 2022, notified as on 31.01.2022.
3. In terms of the above, the present petition is dismissed as infructuous.
