ORDER

- 1. The present petition has been filed by M/s. HPGCL seeking to remove the difficulty arising out of Regulation 34 (3) (iii) of HERC MYT Regulations, 2019 to the extent that norms for the compensation for secondary fuel oil consumption due to Multiple Start/Stop of Units under Reserve Shutdown (RSD), may be specified particularly for 300 MW DCRTPP and 600 MW RGTPP units of HPGCL. The specific relief sought by the petitioner is as under:
 - a) The oil consumption per start up norms for 300 MW DCRTPP and 600 MW RGTPP Units of HPGCL as proposed earlier by HPGCL, may please be approved as under:-

b) Pass such further order or order(s) as the Commission may deem fit.

- 3. In terms of the above, the present petition is dismissed as infructuous.
