



The matter came up for the hearing today.

2. Sh. Abhishek Kumar, Advocate of UPPCL submitted that the instant MYT petition has been filed on 04.05.2020 and since the True-Up order for the FY 2014-19 has been issued on 25.02.2022, therefore, the Petitioner should amend the petition basis the True-Up order. Further, Sh. Abhishek Kumar submitted that the Petitioner should file its details strictly as per the Tariff Forms of UPERC Generation Tariff Regulations, 2019. The Counsel further submitted that RPSCL has filed its rejoinder on 20.04.2022 to UPPCL reply dated 30.06.2021.
3. Sh. Rama Shankar Awasthi submitted that RPSCL has provided only the petition copy on its website. RPSCL should also provide its response to the Commission's deficiency note to solicit detailed response from the stakeholders.
4. Sh. Avdhesh Kumar Verma submitted that RPSCL shall file an amended petition in view of the Commission's True-up order for the period 2014-19 and upload amended Petition on its website for proper comments from the consumer of the Uttar Pradesh state. RPSCL need to be transparent in sharing data with the consumers as ultimately it is the end consumer who bears the claimed cost of RPSCL.
5. The Commission observed that in the interest of the consumers of the state and to maintain transparency, RPSCL shall file amended petition considering true-up order strictly as per the applicable Tariff Forms and publish the same on its website. RPSCL representatives present in the hearing responded that they would file the same as per Commission's direction and sought one month time for the same.
6. After hearing the comments/suggestion of the stakeholders, the Commission directed RPSCL to file amended Petition and publish on its website along with the (a) Commission's deficiency note (b) RPSCL response to the deficiency note (c) Annual performance report for 2019-20 and 2020-21 as per UPERC Generation tariff Regulations, 2019 and (d) details of coal data as claimed in the amended petition. RPSCL shall complete all these activities on or before 20.05.2022 and upload the same in their website inviting the stakeholder's comments/suggestion. The stakeholders shall file their comments/suggestions within 45 days thereafter, i.e., by 05.07.2022. Thereafter, the Commission shall notify date for public hearing.
