### ORDER

(Date of Hearing - 05.07.2022)

1. Pursuant to last hearing dated 17.05.2022, Commission directed the Petitioner to file an amended Petition within two weeks for determination of Tariff for FY 2019-24 period by excluding the details of Matatila and Rihand Power Station. The Commission also directed the Petitioner to serve a copy of the amended Petition to the Respondent and granted two weeks- time to Respondent to file its reply to the amended Petition.

The matter came up for hearing today.

2. During the Proceedings, Shri Syed Saif Naqvi, Consultant for UPJVNL submitted that UPJVUNL has revised the Petition as per the directions of the Commission. However, during the recently held Board Meeting of UPJVUNL, the projected Additional Capital Expenditure for FY 2019-24 period has been revised and the Petition is being revised accordingly. In view of the same, the Consultant for UPJVUNL sought for adjournment of today's hearing and requested the Commission to further allow two weeks-time to file the amended Petition.
3. The Commission allowed the request of the Petitioner and adjourned today's hearing. Further, the Commission granted two-weeks' time to the Petitioner to file amended Petition and serve a copy of the amended Petition to the



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Respondent. Thereafter, the Respondent may file its reply to the amended Petition within two weeks.
