- 3) TPDDL has submitted that they have not considered the bids for the period of 01/09/2022 to 15/10/2022 as the rates discovered, as tabulated above, are on higher side and they will issue a fresh tender to procure the power for the 01/09/2022 to 15/10/2022 period.
- 4) It is noted that during the Summer Preparedness Meeting held on 16/03/2022, Delhi SLDC submitted the Demand – Supply analysis for DISCOMs for the period from April 2022 to September 2022. As per the said information, the power shortage in TPDDL during 2nd fortnight of August lies in the range of 72 MW to 104 MW during 6 PM to 3 AM.
- 5) Further, the Commission vide its Order dated 30/06/2022 has temporarily reallocated TPDDL's 125 MW share of Aravali Jhajjar to BRPL for the period from 1/07/2022 to 31/10/2022 for reasons mentioned in the said Order.
- 6) It is observed that for the past one month, the Daily Price of Power available at Indian Energy Exchange (IEX) is more than Rs. 5/kWh for most of the days and even Evening Power is at Rate Rs. 7.40/kWh. Further, the average rate (comprising Fixed Cost and Variable Cost) of Aravali Jhajjar for the period from Apr'22-Jun'22 is in the range of Rs. 4.98/kWh to Rs. 7.04/kWh. The Energy Charge Rate for June'22 has increased drastically from earlier Rs. 3.48/kWh to Rs. 5.37/kWh due to blending of coal.
- 7) In view of above, the Commission approves the procurement of 100 MW RTC power at Rs. 5.10/ kWh with Delivery Point at Northern Region Periphery including all charges i.e., Capacity Charge, Energy Charge, Trading Margin, applicable charges/loss upto delivery point during 16/08/2022 to 31/08/2022. Further, TPDDL is directed to dispose of Surplus Power, if any, under Inter DISCOM Transfer (IDT) mechanism and maintain 24X7 supply of Power to the consumers. If it is noticed that the surplus power is not disposed in IDT, required by other DISCOMs, and sold outside Delhi, then the Petitioner will be liable for penalty as deemed fit by the Commission.
- 8) Ordered accordingly.
