- 7. - 8. Financial bids shall be opened of those bidders whose bids are Technically Qualified EMD Properly uploaded and found eligible. Scanned copy of RTGS/NEFT Slip of Tender Fees & Earnest Money to be uploaded with Technical bid
- 9. The measured quantity and quality which shown on BOQ may vary and quantity will be paid to successful bidder as per measurement on site.
