PSPCL has also filed additional affidavit further placing on record the letter F.No.09/13/2021-RCM, Ministry of Power, Govt. of India dated 22.07.2022. The Ld. Counsel for PSPCL argued the matter and requested for time to file an affidavit/undertaking PSPCL's willingness to comply with the total RPO of 24.61% for FY 2022-23 and reply to the issues raised by PEDA.

After hearing the matter, petition is admitted. PSPCL to file its undertaking/reply within two weeks with a copy to PEDA (through hard copy & soft copy). PSPCL may file its rejoinder to the reply filed by PEDA within two weeks with a copy to PEDA (through hard copy & soft copy).
