ADMITTANCE ORDER
(Date of Hearing 20.12.2022)

1. The Commission, vide order dated 02.05.2022, in the interest of consumers of the state and to maintain transparency, directed RPSCL to file amended petition considering true-up order dated 25.02.2022. RPSCL was also directed to published on its website (a) Commission's deficiency note and RPSCL response (b) annual performance report for 2019-20 and 2020-21 as per UPERC Generation tariff Regulation, 2019 and (c) details of coal data as claimed in the amended petition. The stakeholders were to file comments/suggestions with in 45 days i.e. by 5th July, 2022. UPPCL has filed its reply to the amended petition on 24.08.2022.

The matter came up for hearing today.

2. The Petitioner submitted that the amended petition has been filed and the details as per the Commission's order dated 02.05.2022 have been uploaded on their website. It was further submitted that the Commission is to notify the date for public hearing and they shall file response to UPPCL reply prior to the public hearing.
3. The Commission has, vide its query dated 29.10.2020, issued data gaps for the instant petition along with true-up petition no. 1529 of 2019. The petitioner has submitted its reply to the data gaps.
4. In view of the above, the commission admits the MYT Petition for further processing with direction that the Petitioner shall furnish further information/clarifications, if any, as deemed necessary by the Commission during the processing of the Petition and provide the same to the satisfaction of the Commission within the time frame as stipulated by the Commission, failing which the Commission may proceed to dispose of the matter as it deems fit based on the information available with it. The Petitioner may also fillet response to UPPCL reply dated 24.08.2022.
5. The Petitioner in accordance with the Regulation 55 of UPERC (Conduct of Business) Regulations, 2019 shall
 - i. within three working days of issue of this Admittance Order, publish a Public Notice in one English and one Hindi daily newspapers having wide circulation in the area, outlining the details of the Petition with ARR and its components proposed, any capex proposed for the Control Period (FY 2019-20 to FY



2023-24) etc., and invite suggestions and objections within 15 days from the date of publication of the Public Notice(s) from the stakeholders and public at large.

- ii. also upload the Petition filed before the Commission on its website along with all regulatory filings and related documents in searchable format. The Public Notice should also contain details of Petitioner's website and request the stakeholders and public at large to regularly check the website of the Petitioner for further submissions made in respect to these proceedings.
- iii. the petitioner shall submit a copy of the original Newspaper clippings containing Public Notice to the Commission within a week from the date of this order.

6. The Commission has decided to hold the Public Hearing on the following dates:

All the stakeholders who wish to participate in the Public Hearing shall submit their written suggestions and objections in hard copies (one original + 5 sets of copies) to the Secretary, UPERC within seven (7) days prior to the Public Hearing date and be present during the Hearing. The submission should also be sent in PDF and Word/Excel format on the email id: office@uperc.org.
