

that they had 0.3% revenue loss on account of deviations in wind generation over the entire financial year 2021-22, which will go up significantly in new regulations. They expressed difficulties particularly in case of wind based generation plants set up earlier under tariff based bidding framework when earlier regulations were in force.

5. CERC representative explained that in the upcoming mechanism, "RE-rich State" has been defined as the state which has greater than 1000 MW installed capacity of RE. He mentioned that such states have been given special dispensation. The regulations also provide for aggregation of schedules at pooling points.
6. Hon'ble Minister directed that the Deviation Mechanism and charges for RE needs to be relooked so that they do not become unviable. Hon'ble Minister stated that grid safety was also important and irresponsible behaviour should be recorded and beyond certain limit, there may be penalty provisions for both Generators and Discoms.
7. To look into various issues raised by the utilities and RE developers in the proposed DSM Regulations, Hon'ble Minister directed to constitute a Committee under Chairperson , CEA with the members from MNRE, Grid India and Energy Department-Government of Karnataka. The Committee may co-opt other members or invite stakeholders in the meeting. The Committee shall submit the report in two weeks.

The Meeting ended with a vote of thanks to the Chair.
