During hearing, petitioner is argued in favour of instant petition. However, Commission observes certain deficiencies in the petition as under: a. It is important to mention here that Amendment of Regulations is separate comprehensive exercise and it is distinct in nature as comparison to application for approval of FPPCA which are required to be approved by the Commission.

	Accordingly, instant petition may require to be filed separately for each subject matter. b. Instant petition does not contain Month wise detailed computations and supporting documents and simply stated that supporting documents have been submitted as a part of Tariff Petition 2023-24. It is important to mention that this petition/application for approval FPPCA is distinct/separate from tariff petition 2023-24 and all the documents including quartly/half yearly audited account is required to be filled separately under certification and cannot be referred. c.BERC (Multi Year Distribution Tariff) Regulations, 2021, have specified formulae for calculation of the incremental charge on account of increase in power purchase cost, accordingly calculation of claim of Rs 0.49 / unit requires to be placed Month wise transparently in the said prescribed formulae. In view of above, Petition is admitted and petitioner is directed to reply/response on aforesaid positively before next date of hearing i.e 24.02.2023.
