**NOTICE INVITING e-TENDER (2 BIT – 2 Envelope Open Tender)
(Tender ID 2023_AAI_175843_1)**

1. Item rate e-tenders are invited through the e-tendering CPP portal by Asst. General Manager (E-E), Airports Authority of India, Madurai Airport, Madurai – 625 022, (Bid Manager) on behalf of Chairman, A.A.I from the eligible contractors for the work of **"ARMO works of E&M Installations at Madurai Airport during 2023-24. SH: AMC of 730 KWp Ground Mounted Solar Power Plant at Madurai Airport"** at an Estimated cost of **Rs. 59.94 Lakhs** (excluding GST) with period of completion **24(Twenty Four) months**.

The tendering process is online at e-portal URL address <https://etenders.gov.in/eprocure/app> or www.aai.aero. Aspiring bidders may download and go through the tender document.

Prospective Tenders are advised to get themselves register at CPP-portal, obtain 'Login ID' & 'Password' and go through the instructions available in the Home page after login to the CPP-portal <https://etenders.gov.in/eprocure/app> or www.aai.aero. They should also obtain Digital Signature Certificate (DSC) in parallel which is essentially required for submission of their application. The process normally takes 03 days' time. The tenderer may also take guidance from AAI Help Desk Support through path aai.aero/tender/e-tender/help-desk-support.

A. Tender Processing Fee, EMD:

- i) Scanned copy of online payment receipt of tender fees or valid MSE registration certificate giving details of such validity for similar nature of work / services to claim benefits under MSE act.
- ii) Scanned copy of online payment receipt of EMD or valid MSE registration certificate giving details of such validity for similar nature of work / services to claim benefits under MSE act.
- iii) SC/ST certificate issued by district authorities (for SC/ST owned MSEs only) for claiming benefits as per MSE act.

B. Technical Bid Containing the following:

- iv) Scanned copy of signed Unconditional Acceptance of AAI's Tender Conditions (Performa given in page No AL 01 of Tender Document).
- v) Scanned copy of Permanent Account Number (PAN) and GST Registration.
- vi) Scanned copy of Form- A - details of similar works completed during last seven with completion certificate issued by client. (Performa given in page No F 01 of Tender Document) on bidder's letter head.



- vii) Scanned copy of Form- B - Financial Information. (Performa given in page No F 02 of Tender Document) on bidder's letter head.
- viii) Bidder shall submit scanned copy of 'Undertaking' on Company's Letter Head that I/ We will deploy sufficient plant and machinery as per the requirement of work in consultation with the Engineer-in-Charge (E-I-C) to achieve the milestones/targets and overall completion within the time period.
- ix) Scanned copy of "Undertaking" regarding Blacklisting/Debarment (**Appendix-B**) & Minimum wages affidavit (**Appendix-A**) on Company's Letter Head.
- x) Companies other than propriety firm shall submit, scanned copy of Authorization Letter/Power of Attorney along with copy of Certificate of Incorporation of the Company under Companies Act showing CIN/LLPIN/Name of Directors of the Company & Copy of Board Resolution regarding Authority to assign Power of Attorney.

Proprietary firm shall submit scanned copy of Authorization Letter/Power of Attorney only if the tender is processed by a person other than proprietor.

- xi) PQ Performa (checklist) duly filled (**Annexure-A**).
- xii) Should have satisfactorily completed (# Phase/Part completion of the scope of work in a contract shall not be considered, **however pre-determined phasing of the work will be accepted**) three works, each of **Rs. 11.99 Lakh** or two works, each of **Rs. 14.99 Lakh** or one work of **Rs. 23.98 Lakh** in single contract of **Similar nature of work i.e SITC/AMC/CMC of Solar PV power plant works** during last seven years ending on **last date (extended date) of submission of bids**.

The details of similar works completed during last seven years in the given format- Form-A with supporting documents issued by client

"The value of executed works shall be brought to current costing level by enhancing the actual value of work at simple rate of 7% per annum, calculated from the date of completion to the last date of submission bid".

The Experience certificate of works completed pre-GST era, the completion amount will be divided by 1.12 (to execute pre GST tax or VAT 12%) to make it par with the experience certificate of post GST era but excluding GST.

Experience gained by executing work on back-to-back contract/ Sub-contract basis is acceptable in the following conditions:

- a) Work should be actually executed by the second agency (sub-contractor) with due concurrence of the owner as tripartite agreement/ written approval. It should be backed by valid agreement and experience certificate.
- b) Payments received by second agency should be reflected in TDS certificates.

Experience gained in composite works for the specialized nature of works were executed by main contractor either by in-house expertise & experience or by engaging the specialized agencies with the approval of main client as per contract conditions. In such cases, main contractor as well as specialized agency



both get the experience certificate for the same work from their respective client(s) i.e. main contractor for composite work along with specialized works from owner and specialized agency for specialized work(s) from the main contractor.

In this situation, the experience certificate of either specialized agency or main agency having in-house expertise & experience, who has actually executed the specialized work(s), shall be considered for Technical /Pre-qualifying criteria in similar specialized nature of work(s).

Client certificate for experience should show the nature of work done, the value of work, date of start, date of completion as per agreement, actual date of completion, completion cost and satisfactory completion of work. Experience certificate should contain work order copy, bill of quantities & completion certificate. **Firms showing work experience certificate from non-government/non-PSU organizations should submit copy of tax deduction at sources (TDS) certificate(s) along with a certificate issued by registered Chartered Accountant, clearly specifying the name of work, total payment received against the work and TDS amount for the work. (In case TDS is not available for supply portion, tax invoice along with client receipt / certificate is to be submitted).**

- xiii) Should have annualized average financial turnover of **Rs. 8.99 Lakh** against works executed during last three years ending 31st March of the previous financial year. As a proof, copy of Abridged Balance sheet along with profit and loss Account statement with **UDIN (Unique document Identification Number)** of the firm should be submitted along with the application. Firms showing continuous losses during the last three years in the balance sheet shall be summarily rejected.
- xiv) The tenderer should have a minimum net worth of **Rs. 4.50 Lakhs per annum** issued by certified Chartered Accountants The Certificate should be submitted in the given format- Form-C.
- xv) EPF registration copy or undertaking that the concern will register with EPF on award of work.
- xvi) Digitally Signed Tender Documents.
- xvii) Valid HT Electrical License.

The tenderer shall upload the digitally signed file of scanned documents and all other documents in support of their meeting each criterion mentioned above in the CPP Portal.

EMD of value of **Rs. 59,950.00** shall be accepted online only in CPP portal.

Refund of EMD

EMD amount of the rejected bidders will be refunded to their source account after submission of Technical / Financial evaluation report on CPP portal by bid Manager.

Envelope-II: The Financial e-Bid through CPP portal.

All rates shall be quoted in the format provided and no other format is acceptable. If the price bid has been given as a standard BOQ format with the tender document,



then the same is to be downloaded and to be filled by all the bidders. Bidders are required to download the BOQ file, open it and complete the **blue coloured** (unprotected) cells with their respective financial quotes and other details (such as name of the bidder). No other cells should be changed. Once the details have been completed, the bidder should save it and submit it online, without changing the filename. If the BOQ file is found to be modified by the bidder, the bid will be rejected.

3. Bid Submission:

The tenderer shall submit their application only at CPP portal: <https://etenders.gov.in/eprocure/app>. Tenderer/Contractor are advised to follow the instruction provided in the tender document for online submission of bids. Tenderers are required to upload the digitally signed file of scanned documents as per Para 2. Bid documents may be scanned with 100 dpi with black and white option which helps in reducing size of the scanned document.

Uploading of application in location other than specified above shall not be considered. Hard copy of application shall not be entertained.

4. Not more than one tender shall be submitted by one tenderer or tenderers having business relations. Under no circumstance will father and his son(s) or other close relation who have business relationship with one another (i.e. when one or more partner(s)/director(s) are common) be allowed to tender for the same contract as separate competitors. A breach of this condition will render the tenders of both parties liable to rejection.
5. Tenderer who has downloaded the tender from Central Public Procurement Portal (CPPP) website <http://etenders.gov.in/eprocure/app>, shall not tamper/modify the tender form including downloaded price bid template in any manner. In case if the same is found to be tampered/modified in any manner, tender will be completely rejected and EMD would be forfeited and tenderer is liable to be banned from doing business with AAI.

6. **Bids Opening Process is as below:**

Envelope-I: (Tender processing fee, EMD, Technical bid and Pre-qualification)

Envelope-I containing documents as per Para 2 (A) & (B) (uploaded by the tenderers) shall be opened on date & time mentioned in CRITICAL DATA SHEET.

Payment confirmation will be checked at the time of tender opening. Payment status will be checked for each individual bidder. Paid information link will be viewed and bidder details along with payment details will be checked. The payment status should show success against each bidder. If the status (tender fee) is not displaying success the tender will be rejected.

If the bidder has any query related to the Bid Document of the work, they should use "**Seek Clarification**" on CPP portal to seek clarifications. No other means of communication in this regard shall be entertained.

If any clarification is needed from the tenderer about the deficiency in his uploaded documents in Envelope-I, he will be asked to provide it through CPP portal if required. The tenderer shall upload the requisite clarification/documents within time specified by



AAI, failing which it shall be presumed that the bidder does not have anything to submit and bid shall be evaluated accordingly.

The intimation regarding acceptance/rejection of their bids will be intimated to the tenderers through CPP portal.

Envelope-II: (Financial Bid):

Envelop-II containing financial bid of the tenderers found to be meeting the technical criteria and qualifying requirements shall be opened on date & time mentioned in CRITICAL DATA SHEET. **(In case the date and time for opening of Envelop-II (Financial Bid) is required to be changed, the same shall be intimated through CPP portal).**

7. AAI reserves the right to accept or reject any or all applications without assigning any reasons. AAI also reserves the right to call off tender process at any stage without assigning any reason.
8. AAI reserve the right to disallow the working agencies whose performance at ongoing project (s) is below par and usually poor and has been issued letter of restrain/Temporary/Permanent debarment/black listing by any department of AAI or Central /State Govt. Depts./PSUs/World Bank/ ADB etc. **AAI reserve the right to verify the credential submitted by the tenderer at any stage (before or after the award the work). If at any stage, any information /documents submitted by the applicant is found to be incorrect/false or have some discrepancy which disqualifies the tenderer then AAI shall take the following action:**
 - a) **Forfeit the entire amount of EMD submitted by the tenderer.**
 - b) **The tenderer shall be liable for debarment from tendering in AAI, including termination of the contract apart from any other appropriate contractual/legal action.**
9. Consortium /JV companies shall not be permitted.
10. Purchase preference to Central Public Sector Undertaking shall be applicable as per the directive of Govt. of India prevalent on the date of acceptance.
11. Concession to INDIAN Micro & Small Enterprises (MSEs) units registered with DIC/NSIC/KVIC/Directorate off Handicraft and Handloom etc. to be given as per the provision of the Public procurement Policy for MSEs order 2012 with up to date amendments shall be applicable for tenders of supply/services and shall not be extended to construction works.
12. Exceptions/benefits under public procurement policy 2012(MSEs) if applicable only for goods and services produced and provided by MSEs for which they are registered.
13. Tenderers have to submit Unique Document Identification Number (UDIN) generated documents like Balance Sheet / Turnover certificate, Working Capital Certificate (works done during last 5 financial years & works in hand), Net worth Certificate, Tax Deduction at Source (TDS) Certificates for Non- Govt. works etc. as per NIT conditions duly certified by CA and having UDIN. The documents submitted by bidders without UDIN shall not be entertained.
