Inviting Comments on UPCL's proposal for determination of Additional Surcharge in accordance with the provisions of UERC (Terms and Conditions of intra-State Open Access) Regulations, 2015 to meet the fixed cost of UPCL arising out of its obligation to supply electricity to the Open Access Consumers for the period 1 April 2024 to 30 September 2024

1. Uttarakhand Power Corporation Limited (UPCL), the sole Distribution and Retail Supply Licensee in the State, has filed a Petition before Uttarakhand Electricity Regulatory Commission (UERC or Commission) for determination of Additional Surcharge in accordance with the provisions of UERC (Terms and Conditions of intra-State Open Access) Regulations, 2015 to meet the fixed cost of UPCL arising out of its obligation to supply electricity to the Open Access Consumers.
2. The computation of Additional Surcharge to be levied on Open Access Consumers, for the period 01.04.2024 to 30.09.2024 is given in the Tables below:
