1. BACKGROUND

1.1 About REIL:

Rajasthan Electronics & Instruments Limited (REIL) is a rapidly growing "Mini Ratna" Central Public Sector Enterprise under the administrative control of Department of Heavy Industry, Ministry of Heavy Industries and Public Enterprises, Government of India; with the aim to undertake manufacturing and development of professional grade electronic equipments and solutions in the area of Dairy, Renewable Energy and IT solutions. The Company is jointly promoted by the Government of India (51% share) and Government of Rajasthan (49% share through RIICO, Jaipur).

The USP of the Company lies in providing onsite service to rural/urban users through a network of 8 Regional Offices, 17 FMCs (Field Maintenance Centre) and 104 Sub-FMCs.

The products/ instruments widely accepted in the market includes EMT, Automatic Milk Collection unit, Smart-AMCU, Data processor Milk Collection Unit, Smart DP-MCU, Auto-EMT, DP-EMT, UMA, EWS, RMRD, RFID, IMMS, MILKO SCAN and other high end equipments.

REIL is in the business of SPV modules, systems, and applications, since 1985. It has capacity of producing over 19 MW of SPV modules. The Company has executed a largest off grid project of 11 MWp and installed SPV power plants at the Atal Seva Kendra at 9348 nos. of Panchayat Samities and Gram Panchayat to power up computer systems in rural areas.

2.0 SCOPE OF WORK FOR BUSINESS ASSOCIATE

Broad scope of work under this EOI is as under :-

- The empanelled Business Associates shall conduct survey of proposed site, design floating structures as per latest technical specifications and Standards, preparation of feasibility report and submission of same to REIL for approval.
- 2. The empanelled Business Associates shall do Study of electricity consumption pattern, Design the solar system capacity to minimize the electricity bills, feasibility study for solar power plant at Pond/Tank/Lake/Dam etc., preparation of drawings such as electrical drawings, Mounting Structures drawings with STAAD report and detailed civil/electrical drawings of proposed solar plants and submission of same to REIL for approval.
- 3. Supply, Installation- Commissioning of Floating Solar system as per drawing approved by REIL.
- 4. The empanelled Business Associates shall obtain all necessary NOC from the concern govt. departments for installation- commissioning of plants.
- 5. Safety & security of materials shall be arranged by empanelled business associates. All necessary insurance shall be taken by empanelled business associates.

- 8. All necessary (as per technical specifications of project provided by REIL) materials required for installation, civil work such as cement, concrete, etc. & all necessary requirements pertaining to project shall be arranged by Empanelled Business Associate.

- 12. In future Joint Venture/Consortium (if required) shall carry out only with Empanelled Business Associates.

Detail scope of work or subsequent terms and conditions for the project will be as per the requirements of project.

3.2 Eol Document fee

3.3 Eligibility Criteria

The participation in the EoI is invited from reputed parties/Enterprises who meet all the following criteria.

1. The Business Associate should be a company registered under the Indian Companies Act, 1956 or Companies Act, 2013 for the past three years or more.

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The Business Associate should be a company/firm/LLP for the past Three years or more.

2. The Business Associate shall not be under a declaration of ineligibility for corrupt or fraudulent practices or blacklisted with any of the Government agencies as on the due date for submission of bid.

 The firm should have experience of Design, Supply of floater with BOS, installation - commissioning with O&M of at least one single project of 50kWp Floating Solar Power Plant in any govt. departments/Institutions/PSUs/private company etc. across the Country during last 7 financial years (ending upto 31st Dec of 2023)

- 4. The Business Associate should have a minimum average turnover of Rs. 30 Lakh/year during last three financial year (i.e 2020-21, 2021-22 & 2022-23). CA certificate with UID no. shall be submitted by business associates.
- 5. The Net Worth shall be positive and based on audited annual accounts of the company...
- 6. The Business Associate should have a valid PAN no. & GST no.
- 7. Undertaking for Necessary manpower to complete the works assigned by REIL, with documentary evidence for the same to be submitted along with this EOI.
- 8. Bidder shall submit the Purchase Order, Completion certificate issued by govt. department/Institution/PSUs/private sector etc. as per clause no. 3 of "Eligibility Criteria".
- 9. Bidder should have valid Electrical License issued by State/central govt.
- 10. Integrity pact shall be signed and submit along with bid. Successful bidder shall submit the Integrity pact on appropriate value non judicial stamp paper with dully signed and sealed after empanelment.

3.4 Area of Work

The empanelled Business associates shall carry out the work in anywhere in India .

3.5 VALIDITY OF EMPANELMENT

The empanelment of successful business associate shall be valid upto 31st march 2024. REIL/committee has reserve the right to extend the empanelment period after evaluation of performance of business associates.

3.6 NO NEAR RELATIVE CLAUSE

The bidder should give a certificate that none of his/her near relative is working in REIL as defined below along with their technical bid as per the attached Annexure. In case of proprietorship firm certificate will be given by the proprietor. For partnership firm certificate will be given by all the partners and in case of limited company by all the Directors of the company excluding Government of India/Financial institution nominees and independent non-Official part time Directors appointed by Govt. of India or the Governor of the state and full time Directors of PSUs both state and central. Due to any breach of these conditions by the company or firm or any other person the tender will be cancelled and Bid Security will be forfeited at any stage whenever it is noticed and REIL will not pay any damage to the company or firm or the concerned person. The company or firm or the person will also be debarred for further participation in REIL's Tender. The near relatives for this purpose are defined as:- (a) Members of a Hindu undivided family. (b) They are husband and wife. (c) The one is

related to the other in the manner as father, mother, son(s) & Son's wife (daughter in law), Daughter(s) and daughter's husband (son in law), brother(s) and brother's wife, sister(s) and sister's husband (brother in law).

Instructions

- 1. The Business Associate shall be required to make presentations related to the information sought in response to this EoI.
- 2. The Business Associate shall bear all the costs for participation in the bid process including preparation of responses to the EoI and must be ready to undertake this activity on its own.
- 3. The Business Associate should not have been blacklisted by any ministry from any country, Government department or customer of the Central of state Government of the country. This undertaking becomes the part of the Cover-note.
- 4. Any information provided in the EoI with respect to citations, Projects handled, Office locations or any other information if found out incorrect by REIL, would lead to disqualification of the Business Associate and other suitable penal actions.
- 6. This EOI does not constitute and will not be deemed to constitute any commitment on part of REIL for any purchase/work order.

7. EXCLUSIVITY:

During the validity period of this EoI, unless with the previous written consent of the other Party to the contrary, the Parties shall not enter into any similar agreement/ Memorandum of Understanding of any nature in respect of the Project and/ or discuss matters concerned under this Agreement, either directly or indirectly or through its subsidiary/ associate or otherwise with any other party (ies).

3.7 Disqualification

- 1. REIL shall not consider for the purpose of qualification, an EOI, which is found to be incomplete in content and/ or attachments and/ or authentication, etc.
- 2. Without prejudice, a sole Firm or a consortium may be disqualified and its EOI dropped from further consideration for, but not limited to, any of the reasons listed below:
 - Misrepresentation by the potential Firm or any member of the consortium during or after the EOI process; (or)
 - Failure by the parties mentioned above to provide necessary and sufficient information required to be provided in the EOI; (or)
 - Where a party has already submitted an EOI as sole interested Firm and such party submits another EOI as a member of a consortium;(or)
 - Where a party has already submitted an EOI as a member of a consortium and such party submits another EOI either as a sole interested Firm or a member of another consortium. (or)
 - Parties convicted by a Court of law; (or)
 - Parties against whom any adverse order has been passed by a regulatory authority that casts a
 doubt on the ability of the party to manage large works.

3.8 GENERAL TERMS & CONDITIONS OF THE CONTRACT

1) AMENDMENT

Except as otherwise provided herein, no addition, amendment to or modification of the EoI shall be effective unless it is in writing and signed by and on behalf of both parties.

2) **SEVERABREILITY**

In the event that any or any part of the terms conditions or provisions contained in the EoI shall be determined invalid, unlawful or unenforceable to any extent such term, condition or provision shall be served from the remaining terms, conditions and provisions that shall continue to be valid and enforceable to the fullest extent permitted by law.

3) CONFIDENTIAL TREATMENT

It is understood and agreed that data, know-how and other such proprietary information that was provided or will be provided by either party, will remain confidential.

4) RELATIONSHIP OF THE PARTIES

REIL relationship with Supplier will be that of a Business Associate, and nothing in this Contract shall be construed to create a relationship, joint venture, partnership.

5) INDEMNITY

REIL and the Business Associates shall indemnify, defend, and hold harmless each other and its divisions, successors, subsidiaries and affiliates, the assigned of each and their directors, officers, agents and employees from and against all liabilities, claims, losses, and damages of any nature, including, without limitation, all expenses (including attorney's fees), cost, and judgments incident there to REIL and REIL's obligations under this indemnity will survive the expiration, termination, completion or cancellation of this Contract or an order hereunder.

6) FORCE MAJURE

REIL and the Business Associates shall not be under any liability to each other or to any other party in any way whatsoever for the destruction, damage, delay or any other matters of the nature arising out of reasons beyond the control of either party, including but not limited to a war, rebellion, civil commotion, strikes, lock-outs and industrial disputes; fire, explosion, earthquake, Act of God, flood, drought, bad weather, requisitioning or other act or order by any government department, council or other constituted body, and similar other reasons.

7) RESTRICTION ON EMPLOYMENT

Both the parties have agreed that they will not recruit any members of staff of other party directly or indirectly.

8) ARBITRATION

The parties agree to use their best efforts to resolve any dispute that may arise under the Agreement through good faith negotiations. No party shall commence any arbitration or litigation in relation to this Agreement unless it has first invited the Chief executive of the other party to meet with its own Chief executive for the purpose of endeavouring to resolve the dispute on mutually acceptable terms.

Any dispute arising under this Agreement which cannot be settled by negotiation between the parties or their respective representatives shall be submitted to arbitration in accordance with the Indian Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996.

9) RISK AND COST

In the event of failure on the part of the Business Associate in the supply, installation and commissioning of goods and services, which is required in view of the pending orders, REIL shall be entitled to cancel the remaining order and procure the outstanding quantity through other sources at risk and costs of the Business Associate.

10) GOVERNING LAW

This contract and its validity, interpretation and performance will take effect and be governed under the laws of India. Venue in any action in law or equity arising from the terms and conditions of this contract shall be the court of appropriate jurisdiction in Jaipur, Rajasthan (India)

11) OTHER TERMS & CONDITIONS:

Compliance with Regulations and Indian Standard: All works shall be carried out in accordance with relevant regulations, both statutory & those specified by the Indian standard related to the works covered by this specification. In particular the equipment and installation will comply with the following:-

- e. ESI, PF & Bonus Act.
- f. Regulation under Indian Electricity Rules,
- g. Safety & electrical Standard as applicable
- i Watch & Ward:-
- Empanelled business Associates shall arrange for compliance with statutory provision of safety regulation and departmental requirements of safety codes in respect of labour employed on the work by the Vendor. Failure to provide such safety requirements would make the Vendor liable for penalty. The department will make arrangement for the safety requirements at the cost of the Vendor & recover the cost thereof from him.

INTEGRITY PACT

Between

Rajasthan Electronics & Instruments Limited (REIL), a company registered under the Companies Act 1956 and having its registered office at 2, Kanakpura Industrial Area, Jaipur-302034 (India) hereinafter referred to as "The Principal", which expression unless repugnant to the context or meaning hereof shall include its successors or assigns of the ONE PART

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along with address), hereinafter referred to as "The Bidder/ Contractor" which expression unless repugn	ant

Preamble	
The Principal intends to award, under laid-down organizational procedures, contract/s . T	for Γhe
Principal values full compliance with all relevant laws of the land, rules and regulations, and the princip of economic use of resources, and of fairness and transparency in its relations with its Bidder Contractor(s).	

In order to achieve these goals, the Principal will appoint Independent External Monitor(s), who will monitor the tender process and the execution of the contract for compliance with the principles mentioned above.

Section 1 – Commitments of the Principal

- 1.1 The Principal commits itself to take all measures necessary to prevent corruption and to observe the following principles:-
 - 1.1.1. No employee of the Principal, personally or through family members, will in connection with the tender for, or the execution of a contract, demand, take a promise for or accept, for self or third person, any material or immaterial benefit which the person is not legally entitled to.
 - 1.1.2. The Principal will, during the tender process treat all Bidder(s) with equity and reason. The Principal will in particular, before and during the tender process, provide to all Bidder(s) the same information and will not provide to any Bidder(s) confidential / additional information through which the Bidder(s) could obtain an advantage in relation to the tender process or the contract execution.
 - 1.1.3. The Principal will exclude from the process all known prejudiced persons.

1.2 If the Principal obtains information on the conduct of any of its employees which is a penal offence under the Indian Penal Code 1860 and Prevention of Corruption Act 1988 or anyther statutory penal enactment, or if there be a substantive suspicion in this regard, the Principal will inform its Vigilance Office and in addition can initiate disciplinary actions.

Section 2 – Commitments of the Bidder(s)/ Contractor(s)

- 2.1 The Bidder(s)/ Contractor(s) commit himself to take all measures necessary to prevent corruption. He commits himself to observe the following principles during his participation in the tender process and during the contract execution.
- 2.1.1 The Bidder(s)/ Contractor(s) will not, directly or through any other person or firm, offer, promise or give to the Principal or to any of the Principal's employees involved in the tender process or the execution of the contract or to any third person any material, immaterial or any other benefit which he / she is not legally entitled to, in order to obtain in exchange any advantage of any kind whatsoever during the tender process or during the execution of the contract.
- 2.1.2 The Bidder(s)/ Contractor(s) will not enter with other Bidder(s) into any illegal or undisclosed agreement or understanding, whether formal or informal. This applies in particular to prices, specifications, certifications, subsidiary contracts, submission or non-submission of bids or any other actions to restrict competitiveness or to introduce cartelization in the bidding process.
- 2.1.3 The Bidder(s)/ Contractor(s) will not commit any penal offence under the relevant IPC/ PC Act; further the Bidder(s)/ Contractor(s) will not use improperly, for purposes of competition or personal gain, or pass on to others, any information or document provided by the Principal as part of the business relationship, regarding plans, technical proposals and business details, including information contained or transmitted electronically.
- 2.1.4 The Bidder(s)/ Contractor(s) of foreign origin shall disclose the name and address of the agent(s)/ representative(s) in India if any. Similarly the Bidder(s)/ Contractor(s) of Indian Nationality shall furnish the name and address of the foreign principal(s) if any. Further details as mentioned in the "Guidelines on Indian Agent of Foreign Suppliers" shall be disclosed by the Bidder(s)/ Contractor(s). Further as mentioned in the guidelines all the payments made to the Indian Agent/ Representative have to be in Indian Rupees only.
- 2.1.5 The Bidder(s)/ Contractor(s) will, when presenting his bid, disclose any and all payments he has made, and is committed to or intends to make to agents, brokers or any other intermediaries in connection with the award of the contract.
- 2.2 The Bidder(s)/ Contractor(s) will not instigate third persons to commit offences outlined above or be an accessory to such offences.

Section 3 – Disqualification from tender process and exclusion from future contracts

If the Bidder(s)/ Contractor(s), before award or during execution has committed a transgression through a violation of Section 2 above, or acts in any other manner such as to put his reliability or credibility in

question, the Principal is entitled to disqualify the Bidders(s)/ Contractor(s) from the tender process or take action as per the separate "Guidelines for Suspension of Business Dealings with Suppliers/ Contractors" framed by the Principal.

Section 4 – Compensation for Damages

- 4.1 If the Principal has disqualified the Bidder(s) from the tender process prior to the award according to Section 3, the Principal is entitled to demand and recover the damages equivalent to Earnest Money Deposit/ Bid Security.
- 4.2 If the Principal has terminated the contract according to Section 3, or if the Principal is entitled to terminate the contract according to section 3, the Principal shall be entitled to demand and recover from the Contractor liquidated damages equivalent to 5% of the contract value or the amount equivalent to Security Deposit/Performance Bank Guarantee, whichever is higher.

Section 5 – Previous Transgression

- 5.1 The Bidder declares that no previous transgressions occurred in the last 3 years with any other company in any country conforming to the anti-corruption approach or with any other Public Sector Enterprise in India that could justify his exclusion from the tender process.
- 5.2 If the Bidder makes incorrect statement on this subject, he can be disqualified from the tender process or the contract, if already awarded, can be terminated for such reason.

Section 6 – Equal treatment of all Bidders/ Contractors/ Sub-contractors

- 6.1 The Bidder(s)/ Contractor(s) undertake(s) to demand from his sub-contractors a commitment in conformity with this Integrity Pact. This commitment shall be taken only from those sub-contractors whose contract value is more than 20% of Bidder's/ Contractor's contract value with the Principal.
- 6.2 The Principal will enter into agreements with identical conditions as this one with all Bidders and Contractors.
- 6.3 The Principal will disqualify from the tender process all bidders who do not sign this pact or violate its provisions.

Section 7 – Criminal Charges against violating Bidders/ Contractors Subcontractors

If the Principal obtains knowledge of conduct of a Bidder, Contractor or Subcontractor, or of an employee or a representative or an associate of a Bidder, Contractor or Subcontractor which constitutes corruption, or if the Principal has substantive suspicion in this regard, the Principal will inform the same to Vigilance Office.

Section 8 –Independent External Monitor(s)

8.1 The Principal appoints competent and credible Independent External Monitor for this Pact. The task of the Monitor is to review independently and objectively, whether and to what extent the parties comply with the obligations under this agreement.

- 8.2 The Monitor is not subject to instructions by the representatives of the parties and performs his functions neutrally and independently. He reports to the MD, REIL.
- 8.3 The Bidder(s)/ Contractor(s) accepts that the Monitor has the right to access without restriction to all contract documentation of the Principal including that provided by the Bidder(s)/ Contractor(s). The Bidder(s)/ Contractor(s) will grant the monitor, upon his request and demonstration of a valid interest, unrestricted and unconditional access to his contract documentation. The same is applicable to Subcontractor(s). The Monitor is under contractual obligation to treat the information and documents of the Bidder(s)/ Contractor(s) / Sub-contractor(s) with confidentiality.
- 8.4 The Principal will provide to the Monitor sufficient information about all meetings among the parties related to the contract provided such meetings could have an impact on the contractual relations between the Principal and the Contractor. The parties offer to the Monitor the option to participate in such meetings.
- 8.5 As soon as the Monitor notices, or believes to notice, a violation of this agreement, he will so inform the Management of the Principal and request the Management to discontinue or take corrective action, or to take other relevant action. The Monitor can in this regard submit non-binding recommendations. Beyond this, the Monitor has no right to demand from the parties that they act in a specific manner, refrain from action or tolerate action.
- 8.6 The Monitor will submit a written report to the MD, REIL within 8 to 10 weeks from the date of reference or intimation to him by the Principal and, should the occasion arise, submit proposals for correcting problematic situations.
- 8.7 If the Monitor has reported to the MD, REIL, a substantiated suspicion of an offence under relevant IPC / PC Act, and the MD, REIL has not, within reasonable time, taken visible action to proceed against such offence or reported it to the Vigilance Office, the Monitor may also transmit this information directly to the Central Vigilance Commissioner, Government of India.
- 8.8 The word 'Monitor' would include both singular and plural.

Section 9 – Pact Duration

9.1 This Pact begins when both parties have legally signed it. It expires for the Contractor 12 months after the last payment under the respective contract and for all other Bidders 6 months after the contract has been awarded.

9.2 If any claim is made / lodged during this time, the same shall be binding and continue to be valid despite the lapse of this pact as specified as above, unless it is discharged/ determined by the MD, REIL.

Section 10 – Other Provisions

- 11.1 This agreement is subject to Indian Laws and jurisdiction shall be registered office of the Principal, i.e. Jaipur.
- 11.2 Changes and supplements as well as termination notices need to be made in writing. Side agreements have not been made.
- 11.3 If the Contractor is a partnership or a consortium, this agreement must be signed by all partners or consortium members.
- 11.4 Should one or several provisions of this agreement turn out to be invalid, the remainder of this agreement remains valid. In this case, the parties will strive to come to an agreement to their original intentions.
- 11.5 Only those bidders/ contractors who have entered into this agreement with the Principal would be competent to participate in the bidding. In other words, entering into this agreement would be a preliminary qualification.
