Record of Proceedings

Learned counsel for the Petitioner submitted that the present Petition has been filed for the adoption of tariff for the 600 MW Wind Solar Hybrid Power Projects (Tranche XI) connected with Inter-State Transmission System (SECI FDRE VI) and selected through the competitive bidding process as per the "Guidelines for Tariff Based Competitive Bidding Process for Procurement of Power from Grid Connected Wind Solar Hybrid Projects" dated 21.8.2023 along with the subsequent amendments thereto issued by the Ministry of Power, Government of India. Learned counsel further submitted that the Petitioner has already furnished the additional information as called for by the Commission vide Record of Proceedings for the hearing dated 20.3.2025, and none of the Respondents have filed a reply in terms of the liberty granted therein.

- 2. Learned counsel for Respondent No.1, JGEPL, submitted that the Respondent has no objection towards the prayers made by the Petitioner and the Commission may adopt the tariff as prayed for by the Petitioner.
