Record of Proceedings

Learned counsel for the Petitioner submitted that the present Petitions have been filed for the adoption of transmission charges for the Inter-State Transmission System viz. "Transmission System for Evacuation for Integration of Anantapur-II REZ-Phase-I (for 4.5 GW)" (hereinafter referred to as "the Project"), as discovered pursuant to the tariff-based competitive bidding process, and for the grant of a transmission licence for establishing the Project. He further submitted that the Petitioner has complied with all the requirements specified in the Transmission Licence Regulations, 2020 and also the recommendation of CTUIL under Section 15(4) of the Electricity Act, 2003 has been placed on record.
