Record of Proceedings

The representative of the Petitioner submitted that the present Petitions have been filed for the adoption of transmission charges for the Inter-State Transmission System, viz. "Augmentation of transformation capacity at Banaskantha (Raghanesda) PS (GIS)" (hereinafter referred to as "the Project"), as discovered pursuant to the tariffbased competitive bidding process, and for the grant of a transmission licence for establishing the Project. He further submitted that the Petitioner has complied with all the requirements specified in the Transmission Licence Regulations, 2020 and the recommendation of CTUIL under Section 15(4) of the Electricity Act, 2003 has also been placed on record. He also submitted that there had been a delay of two days in filing of the present Petitions, which occurred due to the non-reflection of the Petition filing fees on the e-filing portal. He, accordingly, requested that the said delay be condoned.

Considering the submissions made by the representative for the Petitioner, the Commission directed as under:

- a) Admit and issue notice to all the Respondents;
- b) The Respondents, to file their respective replies, if any, within a week with a copy to the Petitioner, who may file its rejoinder(s) within a week thereafter.
- c) CTUIL is directed to submit the following information on an affidavit within a week:
