<b>Subject</b>	Petition for determination of tariff for transmission asset, namely, a) Implementation of 220 kV bus sectionalizer along with bus coupler and transfer bus coupler at Pavagada PS and b) Additional 220 kV bus bar extension works for facilitating integration of RE generation projects at Pavagada (Tumkur) PS under “Augmentation of Transformation Capacity by 1X500 MVA, 400 kV/220 kV ICT (6th) and common facility works at Pavagada (Tumkur) PS” under Section 62 read with Section 79 (1) (d) of the Electricity Act, 2003 and under the Regulation 15 (1) (a) and Regulation 23 of the Central Electricity Regulatory Commission (Conduct of Business) Regulations, 2023 read with Central Electricity Regulatory Commission (Terms and Condition of Tariff Regulations) 2024.

### **Record of Proceedings**

The Petitioners' representatives submitted that the present Petitions have been filed for the determination of the transmission tariff from the COD to 31.3.2029. The Petitioners' representatives requested that the transmission tariff be allowed as claimed in the respective Petitions. He further submitted that in Petition No. 263/TT/2025, the Petitioner may be granted a week's time to file a rejoinder to the reply filed by MPPMCL.

2. After hearing the Petitioners' representatives, the Commission directed as under:
  - i. The Respondents to file their respective replies, if any, in these matters within a week, with an advance copy to the Petitioner, who may file its rejoinder, if any, within a week thereafter.
  - ii. The Petitioner to file a rejoinder to the reply filed by MPPMCL within a week in Petition No. 263/TT/2025.
3. The Petitioner to submit the following information in Petition No. 372/TT/2025 on an affidavit, with an advance copy to the Respondents, within two weeks:
  - I. The detailed justifications for the time overrun from the revised SCOD, i.e., 7.2.2024, up to the COD.
  - II. Liability Flow Statement in Excel format.
  - III. Detailed comparison of awarded cost vis-à-vis the completion cost.
4. Subject to the above, the Commission reserved the order in Petition No. 263/TT/2025.



5. Petition No. 372/TT/2024 will be listed for hearing on **16.9.2025**.
