Record of Proceedings

At the outset, the learned counsel appearing on behalf of Respondent No. 21, NPCIL, submitted that the Connectivity Agreement between CTUIL and NPCL was executed on 5.6.2025. He further submitted that NPCIL is praying for an extension of the SCOD of Unit-4 and may, accordingly, be granted a liberty to file a separate petition or an application in this regard.

- 2. The learned counsel for the Petitioner submitted that all requirements in relation to the Petitions have been duly complied with. It was further submitted that, in compliance with the directions issued vide Record of Proceedings dated 17.7.2025, CTUIL has also submitted the requisite details vide its affidavit dated 1.8.2025. He, accordingly, requested that the matter be reserved for orders.
- 3. CTUIL is directed to clarify, on an affidavit within a week, the reasons for not planning instant transmission line as a dedicated transmission line for the generating station in terms of Section 10 of the Electricity Act, 2003 read with Regulation 12.1 of the GNA Regulations.
- 4. After hearing the parties, the Commission reserved the matters for orders.
