Record of Proceedings

At the outset, the learned counsel for the Petitioner submitted that the parties have not been able to convene a joint meeting to deliberate upon the issue concerning the reimbursement of costs incurred by the Petitioner in the development and implementation of the Transmission Project, as permitted by the Commission vide Record of Proceedings dated 20.6.2025. The learned counsel requested four weeks' time to hold the discussions on the aforesaid matter and to place on record documents in this regard.

- 2. The learned counsel for the Respondent, CTUIL, requested three weeks' time to submit its response/Report.
- After hearing the learned counsels for the parties, the Commission permitted the parties to have a joint discussion on the issue of reimbursement of costs incurred by the Petitioner in developing/implementing its Transmission Project so far, within four weeks, and the Petitioner is directed to file the outcome of the meeting within

two weeks thereafter. The CTUIL was directed to file its response within three weeks thereafter.
