

9) **Eligibility criteria: - Specialized Firms must fulfill the following minimum eligibility criteria as defined below: -**

a) Should have satisfactorily completed the similar works as mentioned below during the last Seven years upto the previous day of last date of submission of bids.
Three similar works each costing of value not less than 40% of tender amount

OR

Two similar works each costing of value not less than 60% of tender amount

OR

One similar work each costing of value not less than 80% of tender amount.

Similar work means work of SITC of off grid Solar Power Generation system of 7.50 KWP or above in a department of Central Govt/State Government / PSU. The value of executed work shall be brought to the current costing level by enhancing the actual value of work at simple rate of 7% per annum, calculated from the date of completion to previous day of last date of submission of bids.

- 10) Past performance of working contractors will also be a considered while opening the tender.
- 11) Earnest money (In original) as mentioned above should be deposited as mentioned in the NIT in the form of DD/FDR/TDR issued by a Scheduled bank in favour of Inspector General, FTR HQ SSB Guwahati, payable at Guwahati, failing which bid will not be opened.
- 12) Firm should have Solvency/Bank Guarantee issued by the banker of the tender of minimum 50% of the estimated amount put to tender. The Solvency/Bank Guarantee should be uploaded with the tender papers and hard copy may also be submitted to this office before opening of tender. Name of work is to be mentioned mandatorily in the Solvency/Bank Guarantee and its validity, if mentioned, should not be less than the time period mentioned for the completion of the project.
- 13) This tender notice can also be seen at website www.ssb.nic.in.
- 14) Rates Quoted by the Firm should be inclusive of all taxes, any increase in taxes during tender period is to be borne by the Firm.
- 15) Tenderers shall submit the postal address. All correspondence by SSB will be made through post on that address. If any letter returns undelivered, the responsibility for correctness of address lies with the Firm/tenderer.
- 16) The tenderer will have to deposit the **original EMD and solvency/bank certificate** in the office of Executive Engineer, FTR HQ SSB Guwahati within the period of bid submission. The Bid document as uploaded can be viewed and downloaded free of cost by anyone including intending bidder.
- 17) The bid document consisting of specifications, the schedule of quantities of various types of items to be executed and the set of terms and conditions of the contract to be complied with and other necessary documents can be seen and downloaded from website www.eprocure.gov.in free of cost.
- 18) It is mandatory to upload scanned copies of all the documents stipulated in the bid document. If the documents stipulated in the bid document are not uploaded, then bid will become invalid and shall summarily be rejected.
- 19) Contractor must ensure to quote percentage rates (in figure as well as words) at which he will be willing to execute the work.
- 20) Bidder should ensure that the document uploaded are legible and full page of the documents have been scanned and uploaded.
- 21) All modifications/addendums/corrigendum issued regarding this bidding process, shall only be uploaded on website www.eprocure.gov.in and shall not be published in any Newspaper.
- 22) However, if a tenderer does not quote any percentage above/below on the total amount of the tender in percentage rate tender, the tender shall be treated as invalid and will not be considered as lowest tenderer.
- 23) After submission of the bid the agency can re-submit revised bid any number of times before last time and date of submission of bid as mentioned in the NIT.

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
