Record of Proceedings

Learned counsel for the Petitioner submitted that the present Petition has been filed seeking adoption of tariff for the 1200 MW Wind Solar Hybrid Projects connected with the inter-State Transmission System and selected through the competitive bidding process as per the "Guidelines for Tariff Based Competitive Bidding Process for Procurement of Power from Grid Connected Wind Solar Hybrid Projects" dated 21.8.2023 read with subsequent amendments thereof as issued by the Ministry of Power, Government of India. Learned counsel further submitted that *vide* affidavit dated 8.9.2025, the Petitioner has also placed on record certain additional information, including the Conformity Certificate. Learned counsel further submitted that none of the Respondents has raised any objection and the matter may be reserved while permitting the Petitioner to file a note of arguments.

2. Considering the request of the learned counsel for the Petitioner, the Commission granted liberty to the Petitioner to file its Note of Argument within a week.
