Record of Proceedings

Learned counsel for the Petitioner submitted that the instant Petition has been filed seeking adoption of tariff for the 100 MW Solar PV Power Project connected to the inter-State Transmission System and selected through the competitive bidding process as per "Guidelines for Tariff Based Competitive Bidding Process for Procurement of Power from Grid Connected Solar PV Power Projects" dated 3.8.2017 read with subsequent amendments/clarifications thereof as issued by the Ministry of Power, Government of India. Learned counsel further submitted that notice was issued in the matter on 12.8.2025, and no objections have been received from any of the Respondents with regard to the adoption of the tariff.

- 2. Learned counsel for the Respondents, AMP Energy, submitted that the tariff for 1100 MW capacity selected under the same tender/RfS has already been adopted by the Commission and in the present Petition, tariff adoption is sought in respect of the balance 100 MW capacity, as came to be tied up only recently.
- 3. Considering the submissions made by the learned counsels for the parties, the Commission reserved the matter for order.
