Record of Proceedings

Learned counsel for the Petitioner submitted that the present Petition has been filed seeking adoption of tariff of the 1200 MW Solar Power Projects with 600 MW/2400 MWh Energy Storage System and additional capacity upto 1200 MW under "Greenshoe Option" connected with the inter-State Transmission System and selected through a competitive bidding process as per the "Guidelines for Tariff Based Competitive Bidding Process for Procurement of Firm and Dispatchable Power from Grid Connected Renewable Energy Power Projects with Energy Storage System" dated 9.6.2023, read with subsequent amendments thereto, as issued by the Ministry of Power, Government of India. Learned counsel further submitted that vide affidavit dated 27.8.2025, the Petitioner has also filed the details of the capacity allocated under the Greenshoe Option, which was finalised after the filing of the Petition.

- 2. Considering the submissions made by the learned counsel for the Petitioner, the Commission directed as under;
 - (a) Admit and issue notice to the Respondents, subject to just exceptions.
 - The Respondents to file their replies, if any, within two weeks with a copy to the Petitioner, who may file its rejoinder, if any, within two weeks thereafter.
