Record of Proceedings

The representative of the Petitioner submitted that the present Petition has been filed for the grant of a separate RTM Transmission Licence to implement the transmission system, namely, "Implementation of 1 no. of 220 kV line bay for interconnection of M/s Anboto Solar Private Limited (250MW + 50MW) RE power projects at 765/400/220 kV Barmer-I PS" under Regulated Tariff Mechanism. She further submitted that the Petitioner has duly complied with all the requirements under the Transmission Licence Regulations.

2. After hearing the representative of the Petitioner, the Commission directed as under:

- (a) Admit and issue notice to the Respondents, subject to just exceptions,
- (b) The Respondents to file their replies, if any, within two weeks, with a copy to the Petitioner, who may file its rejoinder within a week thereafter.
