## Record of Proceedings

At the outset, the representative for the Petitioner submitted that the pleadings in the matter are complete. He further submitted that there is a mismatch in the commissioning of the downstream asset under the scope of WBSETCL.

- 2. The learned counsel for WBSETCL submitted that WBSETCL has filed its reply in the matter vide affidavit dated 9.10.2025. He further requested that WBSETCL not be burdened with the transmission charges for the delay in commissioning of its downstream asset.
- 3. After hearing the learned counsel for WBSETCL and the representative of the Petitioner, the Commission directed as under:
  - a) The other Respondents to file their replies/written submission within a week, with an advance copy to the Petitioner, who may file its rejoinder/written submission, if any, within a week thereafter.



- b) The Petitioner to file the following information on an affidavit within two weeks:
  - i. Since the COD has been claimed under Regulation 5(2) of the 2019 Tariff Regulations for Asset-2, file/upload the CTUIL Certificate as per Regulation 27(1)(c) of the Central Electricity Regulatory Commission (Indian Electricity Grid Code) Regulations, 2023.
  - ii. The details of time overrun due to shutdown issues as per the following format:
