Record of Proceedings

The representative of the Petitioner submitted that the present Petitions have been filed for the grant of a transmission licence to establish the inter-state transmission system, viz., "Augmentation of transformation capacity and Implementation of line bays at Mandsaur S/s for RE Interconnection" ('the Project') and for adoption of transmission charges in respect of the Project as discovered pursuant to the tariff-based competitive bidding process. The representative further submitted that the Petitioner has also duly complied with all the requirements under the Transmission Licence Regulations.

- 2. Considering the submissions made by the representative of the Petitioner, the Commission directed as under:
 - (a) Admit and issue notice to the Respondents.
 - (b) The Respondents to file their respective replies, if any, within a week with a copy to the Petitioner, who may file its rejoinder(s), if any, within a week thereafter.
 - (c) BPC, PFCCIL was directed to submit, on an affidavit within a week, the comparison of levelized tariff quoted by the bidder vis-a vis levelised tariff worked out as per CERC Tariff Regulations on the basis of the capital cost as assessed by CEA/CTUIL as the benchmarking capital cost of CERC norms, the recommendation of the cost committee along with cost estimate, and the complete evaluation report including the number of bidders at the RFQ and RFP stages with quotes, the evaluation of the bids by the BEC on technical as well as financial parameters, along with the minutes.
