The learned counsel for the Petitioner submitted that the present Petition has been reopened following the Commission's order dated 15.1.2024 in Review Petition No. 51/RP/2022, on the limited issue of sharing the transmission charges for the period



from 30.11.2018 to 30.3.2019. She further submitted that numerous opportunities have been provided to RRWTL to address the arguments in the matter.
