Record of Proceedings

The learned counsel for the Petitioner submitted that the pleadings in the matter are complete and requested that the final tariff be allowed.

2. The learned counsel for the Respondent, PTCUL, argued at length and submitted that since there is no agreed Project Implementation Schedule between the Petitioner and PTCUL, PTCUL may not be liable for the transmission charges for the mismatch period. He further submitted that the Petitioner did not reply to its letters sent from time to time regarding the non-requirement of the assets to PTCUL.

3. In rebuttal, the learned counsel for the Petitioner pressed that PTCUL was aware of all the facts; thus, the Petitioner is eligible for the approval of the COD of Asset-2 under Regulation 5(2) of the 2019 Tariff Regulations.



4. After hearing the learned counsels for the parties at length, the Commission directed the parties to file their respective notes of argument/written submission, if any, within a week, with a copy to each other.

5. Subject to the above, the Commission reserved the order in the matter.
