Record of Proceedings

During the course of the hearing, the learned counsel for the Petitioner submitted that the instant Petition has been filed for the truing up of the transmission tariff for the 2019-24 tariff period and the determination of the transmission tariff for the 2024-29 tariff period.

2. The learned counsel of the Petitioner further submitted that the detailed break-up of the actual O&M Expenses claimed for the 2019-24 tariff period, along with the supporting documents, has been filed. Further, the add-cap details, audited balance sheets, and TCC meeting minutes have also been placed on record along with the affidavit. The learned counsel requested the Commission to exercise its Power to Relax and consider and approve the O&M Expenses claimed for the 2019-24 and 2024-29 tariff period.

3. After hearing the learned counsel for the Petitioner, the Commission observed that the complete information as directed vide the RoP for the hearing dated 19.8.2025 has not been filed by the Petitioner. Accordingly, the Petitioner was directed to furnish the following complete information within two weeks:

a) Head-wise details of the actual ACE incurred by the Petitioner for the 2019-24 tariff period;



- b) Supporting documents/ Court order, etc., against which the compensation of Rs. 59.45 lakh has been paid by the Petitioner;
 - c) Liability Flow Statement for the 2019-24 and 2024-29 tariff period;
 - d) Assessment of the Security requirement for the 2024-29 tariff period.
4. Subject to the above, the Commission reserved the order in the matter.
