## **Record of Proceedings**

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- a) Detailed calculations of the interest rates considered for each loan in Form-9C.
- b) Initial Spares discharge statement for the Combined Asset (Asset 1-5), Asset-6 & Asset-7.
- c) Liability Flow Statement for the 2024-29 period, Form-13 and Form-5.

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- a) Detailed calculations of the interest rates considered for each loan in Form-9C.
- b) Element-wise break-up of the Project/Asset/Element cost of Asset-1 and Asset-2 as per the below format for calculation of the depreciation for IT and PLCC:
