**Record of Proceedings**

The representative(s) for the Petitioner submitted that the pleadings in the matter are completed. He further submitted that CTUIL has filed the information sought in RoP for the hearing dated 26.8.2025 vide affidavit dated 19.11.2025.

2. None of the Respondents has filed a reply in the matter despite notice.
3. The Commission observed that the SCOD of instant transmission assets as per the CTUIL is 3.12.2022, whereas, as per the CTUIL's 'IOM' dated 27.1.2020 (submitted by Petitioner vide affidavit dated 16.9.2025), the SCOD of transmission schemes associated with Ph-II of 66.5 GW RE integration is December 2021. The Commission directed the CTUIL to clarify the above-said discrepancy in the SCOD of the transmission assets.
4. After hearing the representative(s) for the Petitioner, the Commission directed SBE Renewables Limited (Respondent No. 18) and AMP Energy Green Private Limited (Respondent No. 19) to file their respective replies on the mismatch of RE generation with the associated transmission system, on an affidavit, within two weeks, with an advance copy to the Petitioner, who may file its rejoinder/written submission, if any, within a week, thereafter.



5. The Commission further directed the other Respondents, as a last opportunity, to file their respective replies/written submissions, if any, within a week, with an advance copy to the Petitioner, who may file its rejoinder/written submission, if any, within a week, thereafter.
6. Subject to the above, the Commission reserved the order in the matter.
