### **Record of Proceedings**

These matters were heard through a virtual hearing.

2. The Petitioner's representative submitted that these Petitions have been filed for truing up of the transmission tariff for the 2019-24 tariff period and the determination of the transmission tariff for the 2024-29 tariff period. He further sought a week's time to file rejoinders to the replies of MPPMCL, in Petition Nos. 494/TT/2025 and 599/TT/2025.
3. In Petition No. 565/TT/2025, the learned senior counsel for Respondent No.7, i.e., West Bengal State Electricity Transmission Company Limited (WBSETCL), sought time to file a reply to the amended Petition.
4. After the hearing, the Commission directed the Respondents to file their respective replies, if not already filed, within one week, with an advance copy to the Petitioner, who may file its rejoinder, within one week thereafter.
5. The Commission further directed the Petitioner to submit Form-7B in the captioned Petitions, on an affidavit, with a copy to the Respondents, within two weeks.
