Record of Proceedings

The learned counsel for the Petitioner submitted that the instant Petition has been filed for the truing up of the transmission tariff for the 2019-24 period and determination of the transmission tariff for the 2024-29 period for the 3 nos. ISTS assets of the Petitioner.

2. After the hearing, the Commission directed as under:
 - a) Issue notice to the Respondents; and
 - b) The Respondents, to file their respective replies to the Petition, if any, on an affidavit, within two weeks, with an advance copy to the Petitioner, who may file its rejoinder, within one week, thereafter.



3. The Commission further directed the Petitioner to submit the following information, on an affidavit, with a copy to the Respondents, within two weeks:

- i. Justification for using Weighted Average Rate of Interest (WAROI) at 10%;
- ii. Assessment Orders/Income Tax Returns for MAT for the FYs 2022-23 and 2023-24;
- iii. Detailed note for claiming the Interest on Loan (IoL) for Asset-1 and the Return on Equity (RoE) for the assets in this Petition, as the Commission, vide orders dated 16.5.2016 and 27.9.2021 in Petition Nos. 119/TT/2014 and 305/TT/2020, respectively, did not allow the IoL and RoE; and
- iv. Auditor's Certificates in respect of the assets for the 2019-24 and 2024-29 tariff periods.

4. The Petition will be listed for hearing on **19.2.2026**.
