Record of Proceedings

The representative of the Petitioner submitted that the present Petitions had been filed for the grant of a transmission licence to establish the “Inter Regional Strengthening between SR Grid and WR Grid” (‘the Project’) and for the adoption of the transmission charges in respect of the Project discovered pursuant to the tariff-based competitive bidding process. He further submitted that the Petitioner has also complied with all the requirements as specified in the Transmission Licence Regulations, 2020.
