- 4.0** 'Class-I local suppliers' only are eligible to participate in this tender, as defined in the bidding documents/ Public Procurement (Preference to Make in India), Order 2017 and its subsequent amendments/ revisions issued by DPIIT. The bidders may apprise themselves of the relevant provisions of bidding documents in this regard

before submission of their bids.

Further it is hereby certified that all the guidelines circulated by BRBCL in pursuance of Public Procurement (Preference to Make in India) 'PPP-MII' Orders of DPIIT/MoP have been complied for the tendered package and NIT.

## **5.0 Qualifying Requirements:-Not Applicable**

- 6.0** Any 'Bidder from a country which shares a land border with India', as specified in the Bidding Documents, will be eligible to bid in this tender only if bidder is registered with the Competent Authority as mentioned in the Bidding Documents.

Further, any bidder (including bidder from India) having specified Transfer of Technology (ToT) arrangement with an entity from a country which shares a land border with India, will be eligible to bid only if the bidder is registered with the same competent authority.

However, the said requirement of registration will not apply to bidders from those countries (even if sharing a land border with India) to which the Government of India has extended lines of credit or in which the Government of India is engaged in development projects.

- 7.0** BRBCL reserves the right to reject any or all bids or cancel/withdraw the NIT for the subject package without assigning any reason whatsoever and in such case no bidder/intending bidder shall have any claim arising out of such action.
- 8.0** BRBCL reserves right to amend any bid/tender conditions through appropriate CORRIGENDUMS published in the portal AT ANY TIME. BRBCL also reserves the right to extend/change the bidding schedule through publishing necessary CORRIGENDUMS in the portal if the situation demand so AT ANY TIME. The corrigendum as decided by BRBCL and deemed fit would be published in the portal as per provisions therein. This prevails over the relevant provisions else where in the bid document. The corrigendum/amendment as published/posted in the portal will be binding on Bidders and it will be assumed that the information contained therein have been taken into account by the Bidder in its bid. Bidders are advised to regularly check the tender regarding posting of Amendments/Corrigendums , if any.
- 9.0** Issuance of bid documents to any bidder shall not construe that such bidder is considered to be qualified. Bids shall be submitted online and opened at the address given below in the presence of Bidder's representatives who choose to attend the bid opening.

b) Special Conditions of Contract (SCC), Section-V, shall supplement/ amend the General Conditions of Contract (GCC) Section-IV of Standard Bidding Document, wherever there is a conflict, the provisions in SCC shall prevail over those in the GCC of Standard Bidding Document.

c) **Nil Deviation:** This is a **no deviation** tender, which means- **No Deviation**, whatsoever, is permitted by the employer to any provisions of bidding documents.
